



8 Best Things to Do in Singapore This Week (20 April – May 2026): Tulipmania, BFG, Daniel Caesar & More

Description

April is winding down, but Singapore’s events calendar is only just heating up. From a spectacular floral showcase at Gardens by the Bay to a beloved children’s classic on the Esplanade stage, and world-class concerts coming in May, here is your definitive guide to the best things to do in Singapore this week and beyond.

1. Tulipmania 2026 – Gardens by the Bay (24 April – 17 May 2026)

One of Gardens by the Bay’s most beloved annual events is back for its 12th edition, and this year’s Tulipmania is arguably the most spectacular yet. The theme? A vibrant tribute to the Netherlands’ rich artistic legacy, drawing inspiration from the Golden Age masterpieces of Rembrandt and Johannes Vermeer to the bold modernism of Piet Mondrian.

The Flower Dome has been transformed into a living art gallery, with thousands of tulips in bloom recreating some of the world’s most iconic paintings. Highlights include a floral interpretation of *Girl with a Pearl Earring*, a recreation of *The Starry Night*, and a larger-than-life Delftware Tulipiere vase at the entrance that is absolutely made for photos.

Look out for the replica of De Kat Windmill – the world’s last working windmill – standing tall among the colourful blooms. It is a genuinely magical scene that transports you straight to the tulip fields of the Netherlands.

2. Roald Dahl's The BFG at Esplanade Theatre (22 April to 9 May 2026)

If you have little ones at home (or are simply a fan of Roald Dahl's timeless storytelling), do not miss the stage adaptation of *The BFG* at the Esplanade Theatre. Running from 22 April to 9 May 2026, this production brings the beloved story of Sophie and the Big Friendly Giant to life with inventive staging, whimsical costumes, and enough "snozzcumbers" and "froboscottles" to delight audiences of all ages.

The BFG is one of Dahl's most beloved characters, and watching him capture dreams and outwit the nastier giants of Giant Country makes for an unforgettable family theatre experience. Tickets are selling fast, so book early to avoid disappointment.
