



Aperia Great Bounce Party: Access, Timing and What You Get

Description

The Great Bounce Party runs at Aperia’s Level 1 Atrium on 31 July and 1 August 2026. CapitaStar members can enter BOUNCE in the app from 25 July to receive separate day, party and reward-hunt vouchers, subject to the terms and availability.

An adult in Singapore deciding whether and how to attend Aperia’s two-day Great Bounce Party faces a narrower question than the headline suggests: redeem the correct passes, arrive in the valid session and meet participation conditions. The table separates the branches that change the answer before the practical checks and worked example.

Choose the branch before acting

Situation	Practical next step
Day session	Use the day voucher from 11am to 6pm on either event date
Adult party session	Use the party voucher from 7pm to 10pm and check its age conditions
Want early giveaway items	Arrive early; selected redemptions are limited to the first 100 each day
No app membership	Create and verify CapitaStar before relying on access

Redeem before travelling

CapitaLand says members can key BOUNCE into CapitaStar from 25 July to receive one complimentary day-pass voucher, one party-pass voucher and one Hidden Rewards Hunt voucher. The event runs on 31 July and 1 August. [CapitaLand Aperia enhancement release](#).

The terms describe the event as exclusive to CapitaStar members. A screenshot is not accepted for the day pass, so keep the live app and account accessible with enough battery and data at registration. [Great Bounce Party terms](#).

Day and party hours are separate

The day pass is valid from 11am to 6pm at the Level 1 Atrium on either date. Participants must present the voucher before entry and wear socks on the inflatables; socks are not included and may only be available for purchase subject to stock. [Great Bounce Party terms](#).

The party pass covers 7pm to 10pm. Read the live terms for age, alcohol and entry conditions before bringing a younger guest; “grown-up spin” is a campaign description, not a waiver of venue rules. [CapitaLand Aperia enhancement release](#).

Free does not mean unlimited

Each member receives a maximum of one day-pass voucher during the campaign. Temporary tattoos and DIY patch keychains are limited to the first 100 redemptions per day and remain subject to stock. [Great Bounce Party terms](#).

A first-come reward should not be treated as guaranteed value. Decide whether the bounce session itself justifies the trip, then regard any item or hidden reward as optional. [CapitaLand Aperia enhancement release](#).

Plan the physical visit

Aperia is at 12 Kallang Avenue. Build time for registration, bag handling and changing into socks, and use the mall’s sheltered arrival or public-transport route rather than arriving at the exact session cutoff. [CapitaLand Aperia enhancement release](#).

Inflatables involve falls, collisions and exertion. Follow staff instructions, stop if unwell and check any participation restriction in the terms. No first-hand safety inspection or queue observation is claimed here. [CapitaLand Aperia enhancement release](#).

Put the numbers or sequence to work

Two friends want the 7pm party on Friday. They enter BOUNCE before travelling, confirm both accounts hold the correct party voucher, pack socks and reach Aperia at 6:30pm. They do not count on first-100 items, and they keep the live voucher ready rather than a screenshot. This turns the event from a speculative queue into a verifiable plan.

The example is a planning model, not a quoted price, official calculator result, medical instruction or promised outcome. Replace its assumptions with the issued notice, live service, signed contract, current timetable or professional advice that controls the real decision.

Before you commit

1. Join and verify CapitaStar

2. Enter BOUNCE during the redemption period
3. Check day versus party voucher
4. Read age and participation terms
5. Bring socks and a charged phone
6. Arrive before the session starts
7. Treat limited rewards as optional

A useful working note combines a **voucher-session-requirement matrix** with a **30-minute arrival and live-app readiness plan**. Enter only details that can be tied to a current document or live record.

Missteps that change the answer

- Showing only a voucher screenshot
- Confusing day and party hours
- Assuming giveaway stock is guaranteed
- Forgetting socks
- Relying on campaign copy instead of the terms

If one of these conditions appears, pause before payment, submission, travel or implementation and reconcile it through the relevant official service. Save the issued result or acknowledgement; a search snippet or forwarded screenshot cannot establish a current entitlement.

Decide what makes the trip worthwhile

Count the bounce session and time with friends as the core experience. Exclude limited merchandise and hidden rewards from the value calculation. If the event is still worth the travel and queue without those extras, the plan is robust; if not, wait for live availability rather than treating campaign stock as promised.

What are the day hours?

The terms say screenshots of the day-pass voucher are not accepted. [CapitaLand Aperia enhancement release](#).
