



Arsenal host Chelsea at Emirates on 6 September with both sides on six points

Arsenal host Chelsea at Emirates Stadium on Sunday (6 September 2026) at 4.30pm UK time, 11.30pm Singapore time, with both clubs on six points from two Premier League matches. Kick-off is 4.30pm UK. StarHub carries the live broadcast in Singapore.

Both sides still perfect

Bukayo Saka scored in the 59th minute at Villa Park after Riccardo Calafiori cut the ball across, giving Arsenal a second straight clean-sheet win after the opening 3-0 home victory over Coventry City. Villa finished without a shot on target.

Chelsea also have two wins from two. Romeo Lavia, Pedro Neto and Joao Pedro put Alonso's side 3-0 up against Brighton before Cole Palmer's 74th-minute finish made it 4-3. Chelsea had earlier beaten Fulham 3-2 away on the opening weekend.
