Most events are ticketed through the following platforms:

A word of caution: always purchase from official ticketing platforms to avoid scams. Resale prices for sold-out shows can be significantly inflated on secondary markets, so verify the seller's credentials carefully.

Tips for Concert-Goers

Singapore Indoor Stadium is the primary venue for most of these shows. Here are a few practical tips to make your night smoother:

Getting there: The closest MRT is Stadium Station (CC6) on the Circle Line. Alternatively, Kallang Station (EW10) on the East-West Line is a short walk away. Driving is possible but parking fills up fast – give yourself extra time or take public transport.

What to bring: Most venues allow small bags. Keep your phone charged for your e-ticket. Wear comfortable shoes – you will likely be standing for much of the night.

Food and drinks: There are food outlets within the stadium and at nearby Leisure Park Kallang. Come a little early if you want a meal before the show.

May 2026 is shaping up to be one of the most exciting months for live entertainment in Singapore in recent memory. Whether you are a K-pop devotee, an R&B lover, a jazz enthusiast, or a fan of Chinese pop, there is something on the calendar that will speak to you. Get your tickets early – the best seats go fast.
