



Best Hotel Buffet Deals In Singapore (Updated May 2026)

Description

Best hotel buffet deals in Singapore (Updated May 2026) can mean very different things depending on how you book. Some of the strongest discounts are credit-card 1-for-1s where you must pay with a specific card. Others sit on Eatigo or HungryHub and change by time slot, party size and date. A few hotel restaurants also run their own seasonal buffet promotions that are worth comparing against the bank route before you reserve.

This guide is built for the practical question: where should you book if you want a real hotel buffet discount this month? The short answer is to start with HSBC Premier for The Line if you qualify, DBS/POSB for the broadest hotel-buffet list, Eatigo if you can dine off-peak, and HungryHub if you prefer package pricing for groups.

1. The Line, Shangri-La Singapore à?? HSBC Premier 1-for-1 Lunch Buffet

The Line is the strongest premium pick in this update if you already hold an HSBC Premier credit or debit card. The HSBC Premier offer gives a 1-for-1 all-day lunch buffet from 11 May to 31 December 2026, while stocks last. The Line runs buffet lunch from 12pm to 2.30pm daily and buffet dinner from 6pm to 9.30pm daily, with nine live stations across its international buffet.

The mechanics matter. You need an advance reservation, the HSBC Premier cardholder must be present, and full payment must be made with an HSBC Premier credit or debit card. The offer is for adult buffet pricing only, with service charge and GST still payable. Each cardmember gets a maximum of one redemption per bill, and you cannot split bills or stack multiple redemptions at the same table.

Skip this deal if you need a public-holiday meal or a special-occasion date. HSBC excludes the eve of public holidays, public holidays, Valentine's Day, Mother's Day, Father's Day and Easter. It also cannot be combined with other vouchers, discounts, privileges, or Shangri-La Circle points earning or redemption.

Best for: couples or pairs who can lunch on a normal day and already have HSBC Premier access.

Book through: [HSBC The Line promotion](#) and [The Line at Shangri-La Singapore](#).

2. Cafe Mosaic, Carlton Hotel 1-for-1 Adult Buffets And Senior 50% Route

Cafe Mosaic is one of the more broadly useful city-centre buffet deals because DBS/POSB, Citibank, OCBC and UOB cardmembers are covered under its bank-promotion set, with DBS/POSB also having a dedicated card privileges route for the venue. The restaurant is at Level 1 of Carlton Hotel Singapore on Bras Basah Road, with breakfast from 7am to 10.30am, lunch from 12pm to 2.30pm and dinner from 6pm to 10pm.

The DBS/POSB route gives adult diners 1-for-1 Hong Kong Kitchen Lunch Buffet from Monday to Sunday and 1-for-1 Hong Kong Kitchen Dinner Buffet from Thursday to Saturday, valid till 30 December 2026. Seniors aged 55 and above have a 50% route for eligible Hong Kong Kitchen buffet sessions. There is also a 20% off mains line if you are not doing the buffet.

This is a good choice when you want a central buffet without needing a premium card tier. The exclusions are the usual ones but specific: not valid on the eve of and on public holidays or special occasions, not stackable with other offers, and service charge plus GST still apply.

Best for: families around City Hall and Bras Basah, especially if you need a lunch option that runs daily. **Book through:** [DBS Cafe Mosaic offer](#) or [Cafe Mosaic at Carlton Hotel](#).

3. Plate, Carlton City Hotel – Multiple DBS/POSB 1-for-1 Buffet Sessions

Plate is one of the most complete DBS/POSB 1-for-1 buffet options because the offer is split by day and theme rather than only one fixed session. The restaurant is on Level 3 of Carlton City Hotel Singapore at 1 Gopeng Street, with opening hours from 6.30am to 10pm.

The current DBS/POSB lineup covers 1-for-1 Flavours of Hong Kong Buffet Lunch from Monday to Saturday until 30 December 2026, 1-for-1 Canton Street Kitchen Buffet Dinner on Friday until 18 December 2026, 1-for-1 Surf and Sear Buffet Dinner on Saturday until 26 December 2026, and 1-for-1 Ah Ma Porridge Buffet Lunch on Sunday until 27 December 2026. Plate describes its Hong Kong theme around classic dim sum, street-style comfort food, seafood and Cantonese flavours.

Reserve by WhatsApp at +65 9232 8005 or email dine@carltoncity.sg. The DBS/POSB deal is for adult pricing only, excludes free-flow beer and housepour wine packages, and must be paid with a DBS/POSB credit or debit card.

Best for: diners who want an all-week comparison option near Tanjong Pagar, especially if Friday dinner, Saturday dinner or Sunday lunch matters. **Book through:** [DBS Plate offer](#) and [Plate at Carlton City Hotel](#).

4. Royale, Mercure Singapore Bugis – DBS/POSB 1-for-1 Daily Buffet And Afternoon Tea

Royale is useful because the DBS/POSB 1-for-1 applies daily across lunch buffet, dinner buffet and afternoon tea set, with a separate 20% off a la carte food and beverage orders line. The offer runs till 31 December 2026 at Mercure Singapore Bugis, 122 Middle Road, Level 3.

Prior reservation is recommended, blackout dates apply, and payment must be made with a valid DBS/POSB credit or debit card. The restaurant can amend or end the offer without prior notice, so this is a deal where you should reserve directly before arranging the rest of your day around it.

Best for: Bugis-area diners who want a simple daily 1-for-1 route rather than a deal limited to one weekday slot. **Book through:** [DBS Royale offer](#) and [Royale at Mercure Singapore Bugis](#).

5. Sun's Cafe, Hotel Grand Pacific – DBS/POSB 1-for-1 Peranakan Buffet

Sun's Cafe is another central DBS/POSB option, especially if you want Peranakan flavours rather than a broad international spread. The DBS/POSB card offer gives 1-for-1 Peranakan Buffet and 1-for-1 American Breakfast Buffet, valid till 31 December 2026.

For the Peranakan route, quote "DBS/POSB" when reserving and paying. The offer is valid for lunch and dinner buffets, capped at a maximum of 20 diners per DBS/POSB card per bill. It does not apply to the a la carte menu, beverages or takeaway, and it cannot be combined with other promotions, privileges, discount cards or vouchers.

Best for: larger family tables that can fit within the 20-diner cap and want a Peranakan buffet near Bugis, Bras Basah and City Hall. **Book through:** [DBS Sun's Cafe offer](#).

6. The Dining Room, Sheraton Towers – DBS/POSB 1-for-1 Buffet Until 30 June

The Dining Room at Sheraton Towers Singapore is a shorter-window deal, so it belongs higher on your May and June shortlist. The DBS/POSB 1-for-1 buffet runs from 1 April to 30 June 2026, valid for lunch buffet daily and dinner buffet on Friday and Saturday.

Advance reservation is required, and the offer is valid for up to 10 persons per card. It is not valid on special or promotional menus, eve of and day of public holidays, special occasions, or with other offers, discounts, privileges, promotions, sets or vouchers. Payment must be made with a DBS/POSB credit or debit card.

Best for: diners who want a hotel buffet near Newton and Orchard before the 30 June cutoff. **Book through:** [DBS The Dining Room offer](#) and [Sheraton Towers Singapore dining](#).

7. Seasonal Tastes, The Westin Singapore – DBS/POSB Semi-Buffer Deal

Seasonal Tastes changed phase on 16 May 2026, so do not rely on older –buffet dinner– summaries for this one. From 16 May to 31 August 2026, the DBS/POSB offer is 1-for-1 Semi-Buffer Dinner from Monday to Sunday and 50% off Semi-Buffer Lunch for every second diner from Monday to Sunday. From 1 September to 30 December 2026, it switches again to 50% off buffet lunch and dinner for every second diner.

The offer is only for adults aged 13 and above. Advance reservation is required, with a maximum of 10 pax per reservation. It is not valid on special occasions, the eve of and on public holidays, other blackout dates, or with other offers, promotions and discounts.

Best for: Marina Bay office diners and couples who still want Westin quality, but are comfortable with a semi-buffet format for the current May-August phase. **Book through:** [DBS Seasonal Tastes offer](#).

8. Crossroads Buffet, Singapore Marriott Tang Plaza Hotel â?? DBS/POSB 20% Off

Crossroads is not the biggest percentage discount in this guide, but it is still useful for Orchard Road meals where a straight 20% off the total food bill is easier than navigating 1-for-1 party-size rules. The DBS/POSB offer runs till 30 December 2026.

Reserve two days in advance by calling +65 6831 4605 or emailing mhrs.sindt.fb.reservations@marriotthotels.com. The discount does not apply to service charge and taxes, and it is excluded on eve of and on public holidays, blackout dates and special occasions. Payment must be made with a DBS/POSB credit or debit card.

Best for: Orchard diners who value location and a simpler percentage discount over a strict 1-for-1 format. **Book through:** [DBS Crossroads Buffet offer](#) and [Crossroads Buffet](#).

9. Ellenborough Market Cafe, Paradox Singapore â?? DBS/POSB 50% Off Buffet

Ellenborough Market Cafe is a strong 50% buffet candidate if you want a riverside location and Peranakan-leaning buffet identity. The DBS/POSB 50% off buffet offer runs till 30 December 2026. The restaurant's current buffet page includes lunch buffet, weekday dinner buffet, a Meat & Foie Gras dinner buffet from Thursday to Sunday and public holidays, and breakfast buffet, with two-hour buffet seatings marked for selected lunch and dinner periods.

Prior reservation is required and subject to availability. For reservations, call +65 6239 1847 or +65 6239 1848, or email dining@paradoxsingapore.com. The offer is not valid on eve of public holidays, public holidays, special occasions, or with ongoing promotions, discounts, privileges, vouchers and other offers. Prices are still subject to service charge and GST.

Best for: diners who want a 50% hotel buffet near Clarke Quay and do not mind reserving around blackout dates. **Book through:** [DBS Ellenborough Market Cafe offer](#) and [Ellenborough Market Cafe](#).

10. Atrium Restaurant, Holiday Inn Singapore Atrium – DBS/POSB 50% Off And Hotel 1-for-1

Atrium Restaurant deserves a separate note because two useful routes are live around the same period. The DBS/POSB card route gives 50% off buffet and 20% off a la carte menu till 30 December 2026. Separately, the hotel is running a limited-time Latin Fiesta International Buffet 1-for-1 promotion from 25 May to 26 July 2026.

The restaurant is halal-certified and highlights international favourites with local signatures such as Singapore chilli crab and laksa. Buffet lunch runs from 12pm to 2.30pm, and dinner runs from 6pm to 9.30pm. The hotel's page also notes a prayer room located about a minute's walk from the restaurant.

For the DBS/POSB route, payment must be made with a DBS/POSB credit or debit card. It is not valid on Chinese New Year Eve, the first to third day of CNY, Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve, and other blackout dates may apply.

Best for: halal hotel buffet searches, mixed-generation family meals and readers who want to compare bank 50% with direct hotel 1-for-1 before booking. **Book through:** [DBS Atrium Restaurant offer](#) and [Atrium Restaurant](#).

11. Jaspe, Wyndham Singapore 1-for-1 East Meets West Buffet Until 30 June

Jaspe at Wyndham Singapore is a May-June deal with a clear end date, so it is worth prioritising if the menu appeals. The East Meets West International Buffet runs from 5 March to 30 June 2026, and the DBS/POSB card deal gives 1-for-1 lunch and dinner buffet until 30 June 2026, except for 20 and 21 June.

The buffet is broad: chilled seafood with prawns, green mussels and clams; charcuterie and cheeses; Singapore laksa, prawn noodles and seafood pao fan; pasta; roasted duck, pork belly, char siew and Hainanese poached chicken; plus a rotating Nasi Padang selection such as ayam rendang, daging rendang, ayam gulai Padang, udang masak lemak and ikan assam pedas.

There are two bonus mechanics. Six diners get a free bottle of Prosecco on weekdays. On 20 and 21 June, the offer changes to 50% off lunch and dinner buffet with one Asahi 330ml bottle for fathers, limited to one bottle per father per table per booking. A S\$8 per pax surcharge applies on public holidays and from Friday dinner through Sunday lunch.

Best for: groups that want a broad international and local spread before the 30 June deadline. **Book through:** [DBS Jaspe offer](#) and [Wyndham Singapore East Meets West buffet](#).

12. Eatigo Hotel Buffet Slots 1-for-1 Best For Flexible Timing

Eatigo is not a fixed-card deal. It is a time-slot deal, which is why it can beat some credit-card promotions if you are flexible. In the buffet category for Singapore, May listings showed hotel buffet slots at up to 50% off across several restaurants, but the exact discount changes by time and date.

Useful May examples included Sun's Cafe at Hotel Grand Pacific with 50% slots, Ginger at PARKROYAL on Beach Road with slots up to 50%, Town Restaurant at The Fullerton Hotel Singapore with selected 50% slots, Kintamani at Furama RiverFront with 50% slots, Element at Amara Singapore with 50% slots, Tiffany Cafe & Restaurant at Furama City Centre with 50% slots, Chara Brasserie at Mercure ICON Singapore City Centre with 50% slots, and Lucent Dining at Dorsett Singapore with 20% to 30% slots showing in the checked window.

The main trade-off is timing. Eatigo discounts do not stack with other restaurant discounts, credit card promotions, senior discounts, kids meals or pre-discounted sets. If you choose Eatigo, commit to the booked time and show the reservation before ordering.

Best for: lunch, early dinner, late dinner and off-peak diners who want the largest percentage discount rather than a specific hotel brand. **Book through:** [Eatigo buffet restaurants in Singapore](#).

13. HungryHub Hotel Buffet Packages – Best For Package Price Comparisons

HungryHub works differently from Eatigo. It is often most useful when you want package pricing, group-friendly booking mechanics or a quick comparison of starting prices before deciding where to eat. The Singapore hotel buffet collection showed several May examples with named discounts and starting prices.

The live examples included Oscar’s at Conrad Singapore Marina Bay at 30% off from S\$57.07, Town Restaurant at The Fullerton Hotel Singapore at 25% off from S\$52.76, Kintamani at Furama RiverFront at 50% off from S\$26.98, Basilico at Conrad Singapore Orchard on a come 3 pay 2 package from S\$54.35, Crossroads Buffet at Singapore Marriott Tang Plaza Hotel at 22% off from S\$65, and Beach Road Kitchen at JW Marriott Singapore South Beach at 27% off from S\$68.

HungryHub is strongest when you are comparing a few venues by final per-person price. If you order outside the selected package, the restaurant can charge separately according to its own menu and service-charge policy, so choose the package carefully before confirming.

Best for: group meals, package comparisons and diners who prefer seeing the from-price before choosing the restaurant. **Book through:** [HungryHub Singapore hotel buffet restaurants](#).

14. Direct Hotel Buffets Worth Comparing Against App Deals

A good buffet deal is not only about the discount percentage. The pre-discount price, child policy and menu can change the real value quickly. These direct hotel details are useful when deciding whether to book a card deal, Eatigo slot or HungryHub package.

Ginger at PARKROYAL on Beach Road is halal-certified and serves local cuisine in a la carte buffets with five live food stations. From 23 March 2026, buffet lunch on Sunday and Monday is S\$59 for adults and S\$29.50 for children aged 6 to 12. Dinner is S\$69 on Sunday and Monday, S\$79 on Tuesday to Thursday, and S\$89 on Friday, Saturday, eve of and public holidays, with children at half pricing. Children aged 0 to 5 eat free at the buffet when accompanied by a paying adult, capped at two children per reservation. Children under 12 also dine free with every paying adult from 30 May to 28 June 2026.

Kintamani at Furama RiverFront is a halal-certified Indonesian buffet. Weekday buffet lunch is S\$45++ and dinner is S\$48++, while weekend buffet lunch is S\$48++ and dinner is S\$52++. Children aged 8 to 12 enjoy 40% off, and seniors aged 60 and above enjoy 30% off. The spread includes roasted lamb leg, beef rendang, ayam panggang rica rica, udang goreng mentega and remis sambal.

Lucent Dining at Dorsett Singapore leans into seafood and Asian-European-Japanese fusion. The restaurant highlights wok-fried chilli crab, shabu shabu hot pot with collagen broth, seafood on ice with snow crab legs and mala scampi, oysters with yuzu jelly and ikura, Boston lobster, roast beef striploin, honey-glazed gammon ham and a dessert spread. Opening hours are breakfast 6.30am to 10.30am, lunch 11.30am to 3pm and dinner 6pm to 10pm.

Town Restaurant at The Fullerton Hotel Singapore remains a reliable comparison point because it appears on app routes and has direct hotel dining visibility. The restaurant sits by the Singapore River and is built around buffet lunches, dinner gatherings and Sunday brunch with international and local dishes.

How To Choose The Right Deal

If you have HSBC Premier: start with The Line for a premium lunch. It is hard to beat a proper 1-for-1 at Shangri-La Singapore if your date is eligible and both diners are adults.

If you have DBS/POSB: compare Plate, Cafe Mosaic, Ellenborough, Atrium and Jaspe first. They give the strongest mix of 1-for-1 or 50% mechanics. The Dining Room is also worth prioritising before 30 June.

If you need halal: put Atrium Restaurant, Ginger and Kintamani on the first shortlist. Atrium has both a DBS/POSB route and a hotel 1-for-1 Latin Fiesta window, Ginger has clear direct prices and child rules, and Kintamani can be attractive through HungryHub when a 50% package is live.

If you are flexible on timing: Eatigo may beat a card deal, especially for off-peak slots. The catch is that Eatigo discounts do not stack with card or restaurant offers, so compare the final price before choosing.

If you are booking for a group: HungryHub is useful because the package price is visible before you reserve. Also check caps: Sunâ??s Cafe allows up to 20 diners per DBS/POSB card per bill, The Dining Room caps at 10 persons per card, Seasonal Tastes caps at 10 pax per reservation, and HSBC The Line allows only one redemption per bill.

If children are dining: do not assume the 1-for-1 applies to child pricing. Some bank deals are for adult pricing only. Direct hotel child rules can be better, especially at Ginger where children aged 0 to 5 eat free with a paying adult within the stated cap.

- **City Hall, Bras Basah and Bugis:** Cafe Mosaic, Royale, Sunâ??s Cafe, Beach Road Kitchen, Ginger.
- **Tanjong Pagar and Marina Bay:** Plate, Seasonal Tastes, Town Restaurant, Oscarâ??s.
- **Clarke Quay and Havelock:** Ellenborough Market Cafe, Atrium Restaurant, Kintamani.
- **Outram and Chinatown:** Lucent Dining at Dorsett Singapore.

Bottom Line

For May 2026, the best high-end deal is HSBC Premier at The Line if you qualify. The broadest bank-card hunting ground is DBS/POSB, especially for Plate, Cafe Mosaic, Ellenborough, Atrium and Jaspe. Eatigo is best for maximum percentage discounts when your timing is flexible, while HungryHub is better for package comparisons and group-friendly planning.
