



Blue Beauties At Gardens By The Bay: Hydrangea Flower Dome Guide

Description

Blue Beauties opens at Gardens by the Bay's Flower Dome from 26 May to 29 June 2026, giving visitors a cool-toned floral display just as the June school-holiday calendar starts to fill.

Who Should Go



The floral display features cool-toned blooms in Flower Dome.

This is best for families, flower lovers, photo-minded visitors and anyone who wants a gentler Gardens by the Bay outing than a big crowd event. Flower Dome also helps with heat and rain because it is indoors and cooled.

Hydrangea-themed displays usually reward slower walking. The colours and textures are the point, so avoid squeezing the visit into a tight pre-dinner slot.

Planning Notes

Flower Dome operates from 9am to 9pm, and weekends will usually be busier once school holidays begin. If you want photos without heavy crowds, try a weekday morning or later evening.

Pairing Blue Beauties with Cloud Forest or Floral Fantasy can work, but two attractions may already be enough for younger children.

What Makes This Display Useful

Blue Beauties is a practical Flower Dome pick because it gives visitors a clear seasonal theme without requiring them to understand every botanical detail. Hydrangeas are visually immediate, and the cool colour palette should photograph well inside the conservatory.

That makes the display useful for families, casual garden visitors and people planning a slower indoor activity during the hotter parts of the day.

Best Visit Strategy

Flower Dome is air-conditioned, so it works well as a late-morning or afternoon plan when outdoor attractions feel punishing. If you want cleaner photographs, go earlier before paths around the floral display become busy.

Pairing the visit with Cloud Forest or a Gardens by the Bay meal can turn it into a fuller outing, but do not overpack the day if you are bringing children or older relatives.

Ticket And Timing Notes

Standard Flower Dome admission applies unless you already have a relevant Gardens by the Bay membership or ticket bundle. Check ticketing before you go because conservatory access is separate from the free outdoor gardens.

The display runs from 26 May to 29 June, which overlaps with the June holidays. Weekends are likely to be busier once families begin planning school-break activities.
