



Children's Festival 2026 At Gardens By The Bay: Winnie The Pooh Guide

Description

Children's Festival 2026 featuring Disney's Winnie the Pooh launches at Gardens by the Bay's Supertree Grove on 30 May, transforming the outdoor space into a Hundred Acre Wood-themed playground with installations and play areas. The launch invitation frames the event around Pooh's 100th anniversary.

For parents, this is the kind of free-roaming outdoor event that needs a weather and timing plan more than a complicated itinerary.

What Families Can Expect

The draw is familiar characters, themed play and photo-friendly installations in Supertree Grove. Because it is outdoors, plan for heat, water breaks, sun protection and a backup meal spot if children get tired before evening.

The timing also lines up with the June school-holiday window, so weekends are likely to be busier than weekday visits.

How To Plan The Visit

Use Bayfront MRT if you are not driving, and decide whether to pair the festival with Flower Dome, Cloud Forest or a simple Satay by the Bay meal. Families with toddlers should arrive earlier in the day or near evening rather than in peak afternoon heat.
