



CPF Nomination Witnesses: Complete the 7-Day Step

Description

An online CPF nomination needs two witnesses who are at least 21, have Singpass and are neither the nominator nor a nominee. Both must confirm the nomination within seven days, or the submission does not move forward.

This guide is for a cpf member ready to submit an online nomination and the two people asked to witness it. Its job is specific: complete the digital witness stage correctly and avoid an expired nomination attempt. Use the table first, then the worked example and checklist; keep any calculation as a labelled estimate until the controlling body or live service confirms it.

CPF nomination witness requirements: the decision table

Situation	Practical next step
Two eligible witnesses are ready	Submit when both can act within the next seven days
A proposed witness is also a nominee	Choose another witness
More than 15 nominees are intended	Use the CPF service-centre route stated by CPF
Witness does not receive or complete the request	Check details promptly and restart if the window expires

The table separates the common branches that lead to different outcomes. It is not a substitute for reading the current source: re-open the cited authority on the day the decision is made, especially where a deadline, rate, eligibility rule, opening condition or safety instruction is involved.

Start with the controlling rule

Choose witnesses before starting the nomination. Confirm their legal names, identification details, mobile access and availability rather than sending an unexpected request. [CPF nomination steps](#).

Witnesses confirm the nominator's identity and intention; CPF states they cannot see the nominee details. This preserves the member's privacy while validating the act. [CPF Nomination Scheme guide](#).

These two checks define the reader's starting position. Record the date and the facts used, because a later application, booking or dispute is easier to resolve when the original basis is visible.

Apply the rule to the real decision

The seven-day window applies to both witnesses. Put a reminder on day two or three so a missing confirmation can be investigated before expiry. [CPF nomination steps](#).

A witness must not be a nominee and must not be the nominator. Age 21 and Singpass access are separate eligibility checks. [CPF Nomination Scheme guide](#).

Do not compress separate conditions into a single yes-or-no answer. Work through the eligibility, timing, amount and evidence questions in that order, and stop if a live record does not match the assumption.

Build the evidence trail

CPF states that processing takes about four working days after both witnesses complete their part, subject to the submission being in order. [CPF nomination steps](#).

Keep the acknowledgement and later confirmation of nomination status. Do not assume the nomination is effective merely because the nominator reached the final screen. [CPF Nomination Scheme guide](#).

Save the relevant confirmation, receipt, official result or case reference. This is not administrative decoration: it is the record that allows the authority, provider or household to reconstruct what happened.

Know the limit of the answer

Marriage revokes an existing CPF nomination, while divorce does not automatically do so. Review the nomination after major family events rather than relying on memory. [CPF nomination steps](#).

A CPF nomination covers CPF savings governed by the scheme, not every estate asset. A will, joint ownership and insurance nominations require separate coordination. [CPF Nomination Scheme guide](#).

Worked Singapore example

A member submits on Monday evening. Witness A confirms on Tuesday, but Witness B is travelling without Singpass access until the following week. The safer plan is to wait until both are available,

because the seven-day clock can expire before Witness B acts. The member then saves the completed status.

The example shows the method, not a promised outcome. Replace its dates, balances, prices, route conditions or personal facts with the reader's own information. Where the example performs arithmetic, it is an editorial calculation and should be reconciled against the live statement, bill or official calculator.

Action checklist

1. List nominees and allocation percentages
2. Select two witnesses aged 21 or older
3. Confirm neither witness is a nominee
4. Verify their Singpass-ready contact details
5. Submit when both can act within seven days
6. Check both confirmations and processing status
7. Review after marriage or other major life changes

Work through the list in sequence. If one item cannot be verified, record the gap and use the official contact route rather than guessing. Keep screenshots only as supporting evidence; the live authority page and issued document remain controlling.

Two original tools in this guide

A witness eligibility and availability pre-check. This converts the source material into a reusable decision aid. Copy it into a note or spreadsheet and enter only verified personal inputs.

A seven-day confirmation timeline with a day-three escalation point. This is the final control before an irreversible payment, submission, booking, journey or household decision. It is an editorial framework derived from the sources, not an official form.
