



Cultural Playground 2026: SCCC's First Children's Festival Runs 19-21 June

Description

Cultural Playground 2026 is Singapore Chinese Cultural Centre's first children's festival for ages 12 and below. It runs from 19 to 21 June 2026 at SCCC.

The theme is Tales and Tunes, with performances, interactive workshops and family programmes built around stories, music, play and Singapore Chinese culture.

Programme Direction

SCCC names Paper Monkey Theatre, The Theatre Practice, LittleCr3atures and BrookieKids among the family-friendly offerings. The line-up is meant to let children encounter culture through performance, workshops and hands-on activities rather than a sit-down lecture.

That matters for bilingual or heritage-focused families. The festival uses play and stories to make Chinese language and cultural ideas feel approachable for young children.



Family programmes include storytelling and interactive play.

How To Plan It

The festival is best treated as a short family outing rather than a full-day fair unless you are booking several activities. Check individual programme timings once choosing between shows, workshops and drop-in activities.

SCCC is in the CBD, so public transport is usually easier than driving if you are visiting during lunch or evening peak periods.
