



Curio – The Outbreak Protocol Turns Biology Into A Weekend Show

Description

[Curio – The Outbreak Protocol](#) gives Science Centre Singapore visitors a short, ticketed show built around biology and outbreak investigation.

The show is listed for weekends, school holidays and public holidays, making it a useful add-on for families who are already in Jurong for Science Centre programming.

Show Details

The official Science Centre listing places Curio at Wonder Lab Theatre Hall F, with a 3pm showtime and a duration of about 25 minutes.

Tickets are listed at S\$5 for visitors aged three and above, and the page notes that this is not inclusive of Science Centre admission.

- Venue: Wonder Lab Theatre Hall F.
- Time: 3pm.
- Duration: about 25 minutes.
- Price: S\$5 for ages 3 and above, excluding Science Centre admission.

Why It Fits The Health Rotation

Outbreak stories are familiar after the past few years, but a live show can make the science feel less abstract for children. The format gives families an accessible way to talk about evidence, observation and how scientists trace a problem.

It is not a medical advisory session. Treat it as a science-communication stop that helps children connect biology with real-world public-health questions.

How To Use It

Because the show is short, it works best as a scheduled break inside a wider Science Centre visit. Plan it after a more hands-on exhibit so younger children can sit down without losing momentum.
