



## Day Out! At Esplanade 2026: May Arts Programme For Lower Primary Pupils

### Description

Day Out! @ Esplanade runs its May edition from 19 to 21 May 2026, giving lower primary pupils a full-day arts programme that combines a performance, a workshop and a venue experience. The May edition features traditional instruments from around the world through KULCHA, a dramatised tour of Esplanade Concert Hall and a vocal workshop by Lâ??arietta Productions.

For parents, this is a useful school-programme story because it shows how arts exposure can be built into a structured day rather than treated as a one-off show.

### What Children Do

The performance takes place at the DBS Foundation Outdoor Theatre, followed by a guided look at the Esplanade Concert Hall and a hands-on vocal music workshop. That mix is helpful for younger pupils because it moves between watching, exploring and participating.

The programme is not a casual drop-in outing. It is built for schools and lower primary learners, so families should treat it as something to ask teachers or school arts coordinators about rather than a weekend walk-in event.

### Why It Works

Children often understand venues better when they can see the backstage logic, acoustics and performer spaces. A day that combines instruments, theatre architecture and singing gives them more to remember than a standard auditorium visit.
