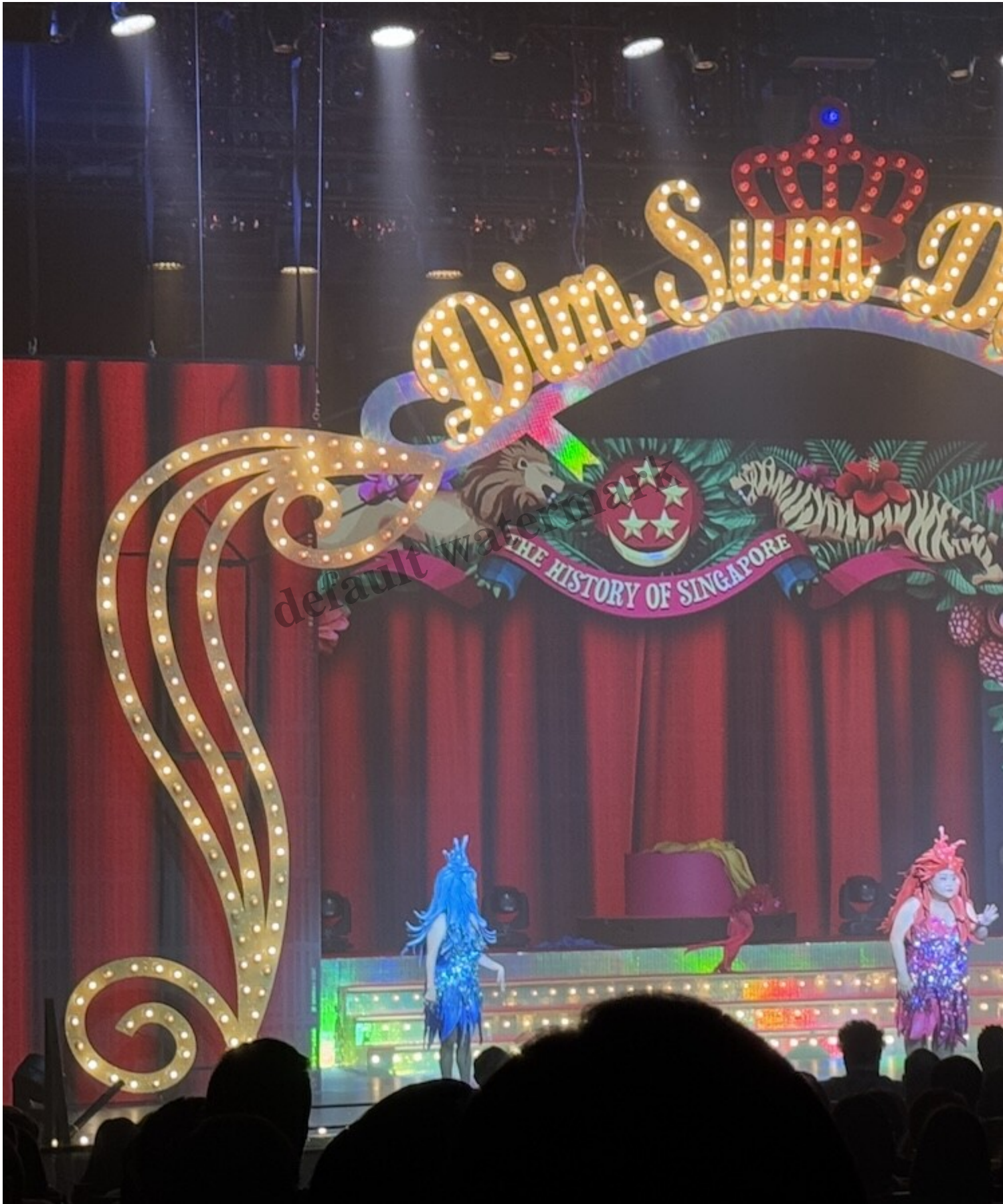




*Dim Sum Dollies* will run at the Capitol Theatre from 12–21 December 2024.

Can anyone guess what this particular skit is about? Hint: "Swimming and Schooling."

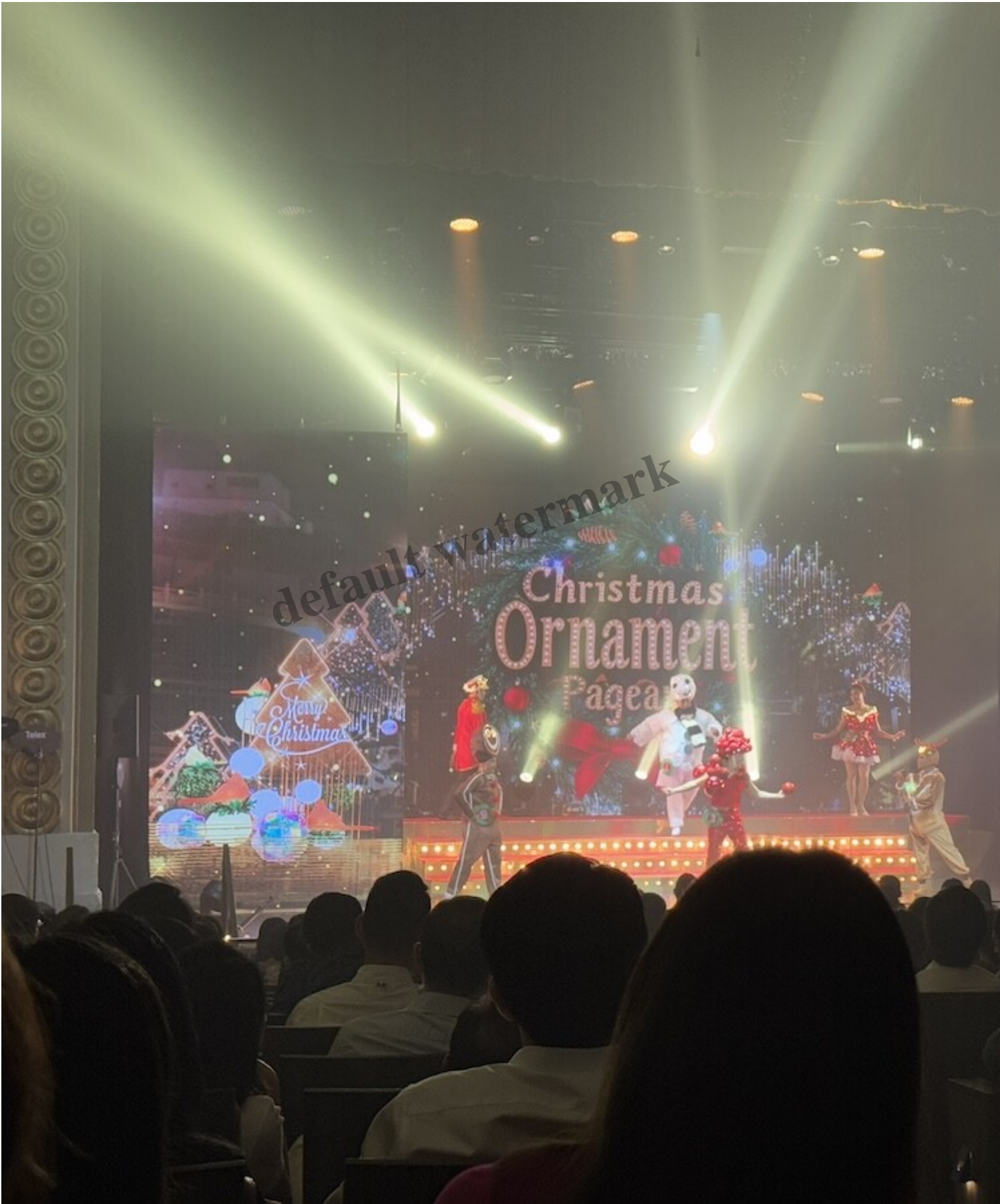
