



EPL Monday: Coventry, Ipswich And Hull Join Premier League 2026/27

Description

The Premier League's 2026/27 season cycle has formally started, giving Singapore EPL fans a cleaner picture of the 20-club line-up before fixtures and transfer business dominate the next news wave. The league says the change from the 2025/26 campaign to 2026/27 was formalised at its Annual General Meeting on 5 June 2026.

Coventry City, Ipswich Town and Hull City can now state that they are part of the Premier League following promotion from the EFL Championship. Wolves, Burnley and West Ham United transferred back the share certificates that gave them Premier League status.

What Changed At The AGM

The Premier League explains that relegated clubs transfer back their share certificates, after which the Premier League Board confirms cancellation of those shares. New share certificates are then signed for the promoted clubs.

That administrative step matters because it marks the formal start of the new league year. It is the point where promoted clubs are no longer just incoming names on a table; they are part of the Premier League company structure for the new season.

- Promoted clubs: Coventry City, Ipswich Town and Hull City.
- Relegated clubs: Wolverhampton Wanderers, Burnley and West Ham United.
- Formal changeover date: 5 June 2026 AGM.
- League status: new share certificates signed for promoted clubs.

Why Singapore Fans Should Track It Now

Fixture release will still drive viewing plans later, but the club line-up already affects fantasy watchlists, pre-season interest and transfer talk. Coventry, Ipswich and Hull will also bring different broadcast storylines for fans who follow promotion battles as closely as top-four races.

The transfer window is another immediate marker. The Premier League's transfer-window guide says the summer window opens on Monday 15 June and closes at 23:00 BST on Tuesday 1 September.

What To Watch Next

The promoted clubs' recruitment will be the biggest early signal. Fans should watch how each club strengthens before fixture difficulty, opening-month travel and fantasy picks come into view.

For Singapore viewers, the useful planning sequence is simple: note the confirmed 20 clubs now, follow transfer moves from 15 June, then build weekend viewing plans once the fixture list lands.

The Premier League's [season-start explainer](#) sets out the promoted clubs and share-certificate changeover, while its transfer-window guide gives the 15 June opening date.
