With 15 races completed by the time the circus arrives in Singapore, the title race will be in its decisive phase. In 2026, the new technical regulations introduced streamlined, ground-effect machines alongside the hybrid power unit changes. Kimi Antonelli â?? the young Italian who has emerged as a potential world champion in waiting â?? has been one of the drivers to watch all season. The Singapore layoutâ??s combination of slow chicanes, hairpins and high-speed sweeps tends to produce results that differ from the broader championship narrative, making it a race where anything can happen.

Last yearâ??s Singapore GP delivered one of the seasonâ??s most gripping nights, with strategy playing a decisive role in the outcome. In 2026, the addition of the Sprint race on Friday injects even more strategic complexity into the weekend. Teams will have to balance setting up the car for a short, aggressive Sprint against optimising for the main Sunday event â?? a fascinating challenge for the engineers and drivers alike.

Beyond the racing, the Singapore GP weekend is an entertainment spectacular. The 2026 edition headlines The Killers and Lana Del Rey across 10 concert stages, making it one of the most impressive live music line-ups the event has seen. Add to that the trackside hospitality zones, the Padang Stage, fan zones and the electric atmosphere that only a Singapore night race can create, and you have one of the world's great sporting weekends.

Tickets remain available through the official Singapore GP website and authorised resellers. The Grandstand options – Zone 1 to Zone 4 – offer different vantage points along the Marina Bay circuit. The Pit Building and Bay Grandstand seats are perennial favourites for their up-close views of the pit lane action.
