



Flower Dome at Gardens by the Bay: National Day Outing From \$8, Orchid Extravaganza's Final Days

Description

Planning a fuss-free outing this National Day long weekend? The **Flower Dome at Gardens by the Bay** is one of the most value-for-money air-conditioned days out in town, with Singapore Resident tickets from just \$8. Right now it is hosting the final days of Orchid Extravaganza, plus free guided tours and a free Chingay display nearby. Here is everything you need to know before you go.

Flower Dome at Gardens by the Bay: ticket prices from \$8

The Flower Dome is the cooled conservatory that holds the Guinness World Record as the largest glass greenhouse. For a shiok, shag-proof escape from the heat, the resident pricing is hard to beat:

- **Singapore Resident** Adult: \$12.
- **Singapore Resident** Senior (60 and above): \$8.
- **Singapore Resident** Child (3-12): \$8.
- **Opening hours:** 9am-9pm daily, last admission 8.30pm.
- **Take note:** the Flower Dome is closed for maintenance on 17 August 2026.

Prices are inclusive of GST, and proof of residency may be requested at entry. The dome sits at a cooling 23°C to 25°C, so bring a light layer if you feel the chill. Recommended visit duration is about an hour, though orchid lovers will happily *lepak* longer.

Catch Orchid Extravaganza before it closes on 10 August 2026

This year's display, themed Rhythm of the Rainforest, celebrates the heritage and biodiversity of Indonesia's regions. It features more than 7,000 orchids, including rare native species and stunning hybrids. The showcase runs until 10 August 2026, so the National Day long weekend is your last real chance to see it. Queues build up fast on public holidays, so go early.

Free things to do at the Gardens this August

Your Flower Dome ticket stretches further with these add-ons, and one of them is completely free. Here is what is on:

- **Free guided tours:** on 1, 8, 15, 22 and 29 August 2026, from 9am–12pm and 2pm–5pm (Flower Dome admission still applies).
- **Chingay: Road to UNESCO:** a free walk-through display from 28 July to 31 August 2026 at the foyer beside The Canopy ticketing counter.
- **Get Crafty! Lily-Adorned Soap workshop:** on 22–23 August 2026, 10am–6pm, at the Australian Garden.

- **Address:** Gardens by the Bay, 18 Marina Gardens Drive, Singapore 018953.
- **Nearest MRT:** Bayfront, then follow the underground link and signs.
- **Best for:** families, seniors and anyone wanting a cool, easy outing.
- **Pro tip:** pair the Flower Dome with the free Chingay display to maximise value.
