



Flower Dome Orchid Extravaganza: Catch 7,000 Blooms Before They Close on 10 August 2026

Description

The **Flower Dome Orchid Extravaganza** is in its final days, and Easties and city folk alike will want to bookmark this before it wraps up on 10 August 2026. Gardens by the Bay has turned its cooled conservatory into a Balinese dreamscape, with more than 7,000 orchids spilling across the Flower Field. It is the kind of atas-yet-affordable outing that photographs beautifully and still leaves your weekend budget intact. If you have been putting it off, this is your reminder that the clock is ticking.

Running from 3 July to 10 August 2026, this edition of the Orchid Extravaganza takes its cue from Bali's Mengwi Village. Expect traditional Balinese architecture, temple-style gateways and cultural motifs woven through the blooms. The result is a display that feels like a mini-holiday without the airfare or the jet lag.

Why the Flower Dome Orchid Extravaganza is worth the trip

Beyond the sheer number of flowers, this is a showcase of variety that you simply will not find at a neighbourhood nursery. Rare native species sit alongside vivid hybrids, all staged inside the world's largest glass greenhouse. It is cool, sheltered and completely weatherproof, which makes it a reliable

plan even when the afternoon storm rolls in.

- Over 7,000 orchids, from rare native species to striking hybrid varieties
- A Balinese theme inspired by Mengwi Village, complete with traditional architecture
- A fully climate-controlled conservatory, so no sweating through your outfit
- Photo-friendly at every turn, from wide floral fields to intimate corners

Make a half-day of it around the Gardens

The Orchid Extravaganza sits inside the Flower Dome, but the ticket is best paired with the rest of Gardens by the Bay. The neighbouring Cloud Forest delivers a 35-metre indoor waterfall and a misty mountain walk that is shiok on a warm day. Outdoors, the Supertree Grove is free to roam and comes alive after dark.

- Flower Dome: the Orchid Extravaganza and its Balinese staging
- Cloud Forest: the towering indoor waterfall and Cloud Walk
- Supertree Grove: free to wander, with the light show in the evening
- OCBC Skyway: a breezy walkway strung between the Supertrees

Plan your visit before the display closes

Entry to the Flower Dome is ticketed, and Singapore residents enjoy a lower local-resident rate, so remember to bring your identification. Weekday mornings are the calmest, while weekends draw bigger crowds during the school holidays. Do check the official Gardens by the Bay website for the latest hours and any conservatory notices before you head down.

If you miss the orchids, do not despair, because Lilytopia is set to return from August to September 2026 with an Ancient Egypt theme. That gives you a reason to come back once the Balinese blooms bow out. For now, though, the Flower Dome Orchid Extravaganza is the one to catch while it lasts.
