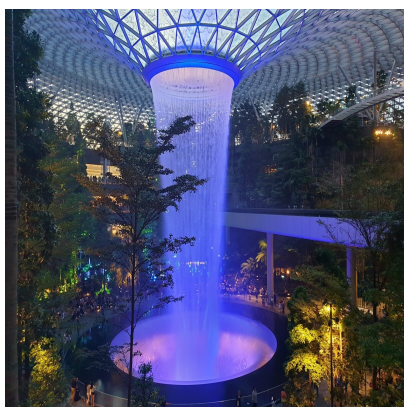




Food Republic Jewel Reopening: Postcard Redemption Guide

Description

Food Republic at Jewel Changi Airport is open again, and its reopening redemption runs from 3 to 31 July 2026. Spend at least S\$18 at Food Republic Jewel, using no more than two original same-day receipts, and you can redeem a random mini postcard with stamp, an I Love SG scent tag and an I Love SG voucher while stocks last. The official campaign counter operates from 11am to 8pm daily.

This guide is for a traveller, airport pick-up party or east-side diner deciding whether the keepsake is worth planning around. It separates the food court's operating hours from the shorter redemption window and turns the terms into a simple receipt check.

Food Republic Jewel redemption at a glance

Gift	Random postcard with stamp, scent tag and voucher	Accept that designs cannot be selected or exchanged
Availability	While stocks last	Do not make a purchase solely on an assumed gift

The details above come from [Jewel's official campaign terms](#). Jewel's separate [Food Republic tenant directory](#) controls the venue listing and current opening hours. The campaign page identifies the redemption location as #B2-238/239; the tenant directory lists the broader Food Republic footprint as

#B2-238/239/240. That is not necessarily a contradiction: use the campaign counter specified in the promotion terms.

The receipt test before you queue

1. Confirm both receipts show Food Republic Jewel and the current date.
2. Add the eligible totals; the sum must reach at least S\$18.
3. Count the receipts. Three smaller receipts do not meet the published “up to two” rule even if their total exceeds S\$18.
4. Keep the originals legible and unaltered until the redemption is complete.
5. Check that it is before 8pm and ask whether stock remains before making an extra purchase.

LBRD spend-gap examples

Receipts	Calculation	Published rule outcome
S\$10.50 + S\$8.20	S\$18.70 across two receipts	Meets the stated spend and receipt-count thresholds
S\$17.80	S\$0.20 below S\$18	Does not meet the threshold
S\$7 + S\$6 + S\$6	S\$19 across three receipts	Exceeds the two-receipt limit

These are LBRD arithmetic examples, not actual transaction prices or a guarantee of redemption. The operator retains the right to amend the terms, and stock can run out.

Match the visit to your airport plan

Food Republic is on Basement 2 in Jewel’s public area. If you are meeting an arriving passenger, leave enough buffer for baggage and immigration variation rather than ordering against a precise landing time. If you are departing, do not let the redemption queue reduce your airline’s required check-in or gate buffer. Changi Airport’s [official transport and directions page](#) should be checked for the current route to the airport.

Who should skip the redemption

Skip it if you would spend more than planned merely to close a small gap, need a particular postcard design, cannot reach the counter during its stated hours or would be upset if stock has finished. The keepsake is a promotional extra, not a discount that reduces the price of the meal.

Final checklist

- The official page still shows the campaign as live.
- Your spend reaches S\$18 on no more than two same-day receipts.
- You have the original receipts, not only photographs.

- You can reach #B2-238/239 before the 8pm cut-off.
- You accept a random design and while-stocks-last availability.

Sources checked 22 July 2026. LBRD did not redeem the campaign or inspect stock at the counter; no first-hand availability claim is made.

Plan one purchase, not a receipt chase

Before ordering, estimate the group's natural meal spend. If it already exceeds S\$18, the redemption is a possible bonus. If it falls below the threshold, compare the gap with something the group actually wants. Adding S\$4 of unwanted food to close a S\$3 gap makes the keepsake cost at least that extra S\$4; it is not "free" in a household budget.

Situation	Best next step	Reason
Natural spend is S\$22	Keep the receipt and ask about stock	No additional purchase is needed
Natural spend is S\$16	Buy an extra item only if it will be consumed	Avoid food waste and false savings
Two diners pay separately	Keep both originals and combine them at redemption	The rules allow up to two same-day receipts
Three separate payments	Do not assume all three can be combined	The published cap is two receipts

Build a 30-minute airport buffer

An efficient sequence is to order, photograph the receipts for your own record, keep the originals together, eat, then walk to the counter before leaving Basement 2. Allow time to clarify an ineligible receipt without compromising a flight, transport connection or passenger pickup. The 30 minutes is an LBRD planning buffer, not a measured queue time or operator promise.

If stock has finished, the meal should still make sense on its own. That test keeps the page useful after the keepsake is gone and prevents the promotion from becoming the sole reason for spending.

What this guide does not establish

It does not verify which individual stalls count toward the spend, the monetary value or expiry of the I Love SG voucher, live stock at a particular hour, or whether a damaged receipt will be accepted. Those are counter-level facts. Ask before ordering if any point would change the purchase.
