## GovTech Industry Engagement 2026: What Partners Should Know Before 19 May

### Description

GovTech Industry Engagement 2026 takes place on Tuesday, 19 May 2026 as an in-person event for business leaders, industry partners and public-sector stakeholders. The official page says registration is closed, but the event still matters for firms watching Singapore's digitalisation direction.

The programme is framed around GovTech's strategic priorities, partnership opportunities and emerging digital initiatives.

### What To Watch

Technology vendors should watch for signals around public-sector digitalisation, procurement priorities and new collaboration areas. AI, data platforms, cybersecurity, citizen services and cloud transformation are likely to remain important lenses.

For smaller firms, the useful work is to translate any public announcements into concrete capability gaps: what can you build, integrate, secure or operate better than a larger incumbent?

If you are not attending, check GovTech's event updates and follow-up materials after 19 May. Industry engagement sessions often shape the language agencies and vendors use in later tenders, partner briefings and pilot calls.
