



Hachi Restaurant Brings Kyoto-Style Omakase To Keppel South Central

Description

Hachi Restaurant gives Tanjong Pagar diners a polished new Japanese option at Keppel South Central. The restaurant presents itself around Kyoto-style kappo dining and omakase, with a counter-led room that suits diners who like watching the kitchen work through each course.

For Singapore readers, the useful point is location. Keppel South Central sits close to Tanjong Pagar MRT, offices, hotels and the broader Telok Ayer dining belt, so Hachi can work as a weekday client meal, a quiet date-night booking or a small celebration where the venue matters as much as the food.

What To Expect

The restaurant's own imagery shows a counter-focused layout, an open kitchen and private rooms. That matters because omakase restaurants can feel either formal or cramped; Hachi appears built for both chef-facing seats and groups that need privacy.

The menu direction is seasonal Japanese rather than a la carte grazing. Diners should expect a paced meal and should book with dietary needs clearly stated ahead of time, especially for shellfish, raw fish, alcohol-based sauces or strong dashi ingredients.

- Address area: Keppel South Central, Tanjong Pagar.
- Format: Kyoto-style kappo and omakase dining.
- Best fit: special meals, business dining and diners who prefer counter service.

Planning Notes

Book before turning up. A restaurant built around counter service and private rooms usually has fewer walk-in seats than a casual izakaya, and the location will draw after-work demand from nearby offices.

- Nearest practical MRT area: Tanjong Pagar.
- Ask about menu price, start time and cancellation terms when reserving.
- Tell the restaurant early if the meal is for a celebration or client dinner.
