



Halal Buffet Deals in Singapore (August 2026): 1-for-1, 20% Off and SG61 Feasts From \$44/pax With Your Credit Card

If you have been waiting for the right moment to book a halal buffet, this is it. August is quietly the best buffet month of the Singapore calendar, because National Day pushes hotels into SG61 pricing and the mid-year bank dining campaigns are all still live. The catch is timing: two of the strongest halal buffet

deals in Singapore expire on 31 August 2026, so this is a book-now month, not a browse-later one. We have pulled together the top halal-certified buffets with a live credit card or membership promotion attached, each with the real price, the card you need and the exact end date.

A quick word of warning before you get excited: the headline number is almost never what you actually pay. Every price marked **++** excludes the 10% service charge and 9% GST. Multiply by roughly 1.199 to get the nett figure you hand over at the till. Budget for it, because buffets are one of the few places where the extras add a meaningful amount.

## Three rules before you book any halal buffet deal

Most people lose a 1-for-1 at the point of booking, not the point of paying. Get these three things right and you will walk away with the discount intact.

- **Reserve and say the promotion out loud.** Nearly every bank tie-up needs an advance booking made under the offer, so use phrasing like “a table for two, on the UOB 1-for-1 buffet promotion”.
- **Bring the physical card.** Several banks exclude digital wallet payments on dining promotions, and the card usually has to settle the full bill in one transaction.
- **Go in even numbers.** 1-for-1 pairs diners, so if you are three or five, the extra person often pays full price unless the venue has a specific odd-diner rule.

## The best halal buffet deals in Singapore right now, at a glance

Here are the top halal buffet deals in Singapore for August 2026, ranked by urgency. The two SG61 offers that expire on 31 August come first.

### 1. Permata @ Gedung Kuning: the best-value halal buffet, and no card needed

This is the standout deal on the list, and the only one that needs no credit card at all. Permata’s SG61 National Day buffet runs 1-for-1, so two adults pay for one: lunch is \$44++ each against a usual price of \$88++, and dinner is \$54++ each against \$108++. The spread is fully halal, with more than 50 local dishes curated by Chef Mel Dean, including chicken rice, nasi lemak, Nyonya laksa, curries and a

DIY mee siam station.

The setting is half the appeal, because Gedung Kuning is the restored Yellow Mansion in Kampong Glam at 73 Sultan Gate, a few minutes from Bugis MRT. It runs only from 1 July to 31 August 2026, and weekend slots go early. Reserve ahead and treat this as the first one to book, because it disappears at the end of the month.

## 2. Carousel @ Royal Plaza on Scotts: the SG61 lobster feast



Carousel is arguably the most famous halal buffet in Singapore, and every station is certified halal by MUIS. Its National Day highlight is a halal lobster lunch buffet at \$61++ per adult, running from 21 July to 31 August 2026. That is the SG61 hook, and it also ends on 31 August, so pair it with Permata on your shortlist.

Outside the National Day window, the everyday value comes from memberships and cards. SAFRA members get 20% off the total food bill from 1 January to 30 November 2026, which is one of the deepest ongoing discounts on any halal hotel buffet. Selected bank cards also run periodic discounts of around 15% to 20%, so it is worth asking what is live when you book. Carousel sits at 25 Scotts Road near Orchard, and reservations are strongly recommended.

### 3. Atrium Restaurant @ Holiday Inn Singapore Atrium: 1-for-1 that runs into September

This is the newest arrival, and it runs the deepest into September, which makes it the pick if you miss the 31 August cut-off. Atrium Restaurant's halal SG61 buffet, "Nyonya Meets The World", is a Peranakan-leaning spread with steamed fish in Nyonya spicy sauce, Singapore chilli slipper lobster, hawker-style oyster omelette and even a durian creamy pasta. Adults get 1-for-1, so weekday lunch at a usual \$99++ works out to roughly \$49.50++ a head.

There is a neat fix for odd-numbered groups here that most buffets do not offer. If you are three or five, DBS/POSB, Citibank or UOB cards get 50% off the extra diner. Usual prices run from \$99++ for weekday lunch up to \$129++ for weekend dinner, and the deal runs 27 July to 9 September 2026 at Level 4, 317 Outram Road.

## 4. The Landmark @ Village Hotel Bugis: the UOB pick

If UOB is what sits in your wallet, this is your buffet. The Landmark has built a loyal following on a halal-certified international spread that leans hard into North Indian, Mediterranean and local Singaporean cooking. Walk-in pricing runs from \$85.90++ per adult, so a 1-for-1 weekday lunch lands at roughly \$42.95++ a head.

It is a poolside setting on Level 5 at 390 Victoria Street, about six minutesâ?? walk from Bugis MRT and directly across from Sultan Mosque. The 1-for-1 is a UOB card deal and it runs on an ongoing basis rather than a National Day window. Reserve ahead, especially for dinner and weekends, because the queues here are real.

## 5. Straits Kitchen @ Grand Hyatt: hawker classics, done halal

Straits Kitchen is the halal buffet for people who want hawker favourites in a hotel setting. Every station is halal-certified, and the live cooking covers satay, laksa, roti prata, chicken rice and rojak. Adult lunch pricing sits at roughly \$68++ to \$72++, before any card discount.

The value lever here is the card. Citibank cards get 15% off across 2026, and Maybank cards also run a 15% off lunch and dinner promotion. It sits at 10 Scotts Road inside Grand Hyatt Singapore, a short walk from Orchard MRT, and it is a strong choice if you want breadth of local dishes without leaving an air-conditioned dining room.

## 6. Peppermint @ PARKROYAL COLLECTION Marina Bay: the award winner

Peppermint is the modern, sustainability-minded option, and it was named Best Hotel Buffet in the Honeycombers Love Local Awards 2025. The whole buffet is halal-certified, and it has earned the top tier of the Singapore Food Agencyâ??s Farm-to-Table recognition programme. The line-up rotates through themed runs, from Taiwanese street food to Southern Italian and Mediterranean.

The smartest way to save here is to book off-peak slots through Eatigo, where discounts can reach up to 50%. It sits at 6 Raffles Boulevard in Marina Bay, an easy walk from Promenade MRT. Check for any live bank-card offers at the time of booking, since these change through the year.

## How to lock in your credit card discount

The discount is only as good as your booking. Follow this order and you will not lose it at the till.

1. **Match the card to the buffet.** UOB for The Landmark, Citibank or Maybank for Straits Kitchen, and DBS/POSB, Citibank or UOB for the Atrium odd-diner offer.

2. **Book under the promotion by name.** State the exact offer when you reserve, because walk-ins frequently do not qualify.
3. **Check the session, not just the day.** Lunch, dinner and weekend prices differ, and the promotion does not always cover every session.
4. **Pay with the physical card in one transaction.** Split bills and digital wallets are the two most common reasons a discount gets rejected.

## Is it really halal? How to be sure

Halal certification can change, so it pays to confirm before you go. Carousel, The Landmark, Straits Kitchen and Peppermint hold halal certification across their stations, and Permata serves a fully halal menu. A few quick checks will keep you covered.

- Look for the MUIS halal certificate displayed at the restaurant entrance or on its official website.
- Confirm that the certification covers the whole buffet, not just selected stations.
- If in doubt, call the outlet directly before booking, because certification status is reviewed periodically.

## Frequently asked questions

### Which halal buffet deals in Singapore end on 31 August 2026?

Two of the strongest ones. Permata's SG61 halal buffet at Gedung Kuning runs 1-for-1 until 31 August, at \$44++ per adult for lunch and \$54++ for dinner. Carousel's SG61 halal lobster lunch buffet at \$61++ per adult also ends on 31 August, so book both before the month closes.

### What is the cheapest halal buffet deal right now?

Permata offers the best headline value through its 1-for-1, landing two adults at about \$44++ each for a lunch that usually costs \$88++. If you hold a SAFRA membership, Carousel's flat 20% off the total food bill is the deepest ongoing discount and runs all the way to 30 November 2026. For an everyday card deal, Straits Kitchen at 15% off with Citibank or Maybank is easy to use.

### Do these prices include GST and service charge?

No. Every price marked â??++â?• excludes the 10% service charge and 9% GST, which are added at the till. Multiply the â??++â?• figure by roughly 1.199 to get the nett price, so a \$44++ lunch is about \$53 nett.

### Which halal buffets do not need a credit card?

Permata's SG61 buffet is open to everyone with no card requirement, and its 1-for-1 applies to all diners. Carousel's SG61 lobster lunch is also open to all at \$61++, though the extra 20% off is a SAFRA membersâ?? perk. Everything else on this list is linked to a specific bank card, so check the venue you are visiting.
