



## Hamlet At SIFA 2026: Teatro La Plaza's Inclusive Shakespeare Guide

### Description

Hamlet by Teatro La Plaza runs at SIFA 2026 from 21 to 23 May at Drama Centre Theatre. The Peruvian company's staging reimagines Shakespeare's play through eight actors with Down syndrome, turning a familiar text into a work about voice, inheritance, exclusion and who gets to stand at the centre of a classic.

The production is 95 minutes long, with tickets listed from S\$32.30 before booking fees.

## Who Should Watch It

This is one for audiences who want theatre with a clear social and artistic point of view. It is not a conventional Hamlet built around court intrigue alone; the draw is how the performers use the play to speak back to expectations placed on them.

The ticketing page lists advisories across different sessions, including nudity or coarse language depending on performance timing, so check the exact session before booking.

## Before You Book

No admission is allowed for persons below six, and latecomers may be admitted only at suitable moments. If you are booking as a group, decide whether the advisory fits everyone before choosing seats.
