Description

Happibox is now open at SingPost Centre #01-122, giving Paya Lebar shoppers a new stop for designer art toys, quirky blind boxes and giftable collectibles.

The mall listing runs from 19 May to 19 June 2026. Happibox describes itself as a Singapore-based team that has been around since 2018, with a focus on toys as art rather than only children toys.

What The Store Is About

The useful distinction is product type. Happibox is about designer art toys and blind boxes, so it fits collectors, casual gift buyers and shoppers who like surprise-format items.

Who Should Stop By

This is a good fit for shoppers who already collect blind boxes or want a low-pressure gift stop near Paya Lebar MRT. It is less about a large toy-superstore range and more about curated, character-led finds.

If you are buying as a gift, pay attention to whether the recipient enjoys sealed-box surprises. Some collectors love the uncertainty; others prefer choosing an exact character.

Planning Notes

SingPost Centre is easy to combine with food, errands and nearby malls, so Happibox works well as a quick browse rather than a long destination stop.

For popular blind-box lines, visit earlier in the day or before the final listing week. Small specialty stores can sell through character ranges quickly when a design becomes popular.
