



Harvey Norman Buy More Save More: Up To \$300 In Gift Cards, Ends 31 August

Description

Harvey Norman Buy More Save More is running until 31 August 2026, and the headline is simple enough: spend more, get gift cards back. Up to \$300 in Harvey Norman gift cards, tiered to your qualifying spend.

Five days left at time of writing. If you have been circling a fridge or a mattress since National Day, this is the week to stop circling.

What Harvey Norman Buy More Save More covers

- Electronics and TVs
- Computers and IT
- Home appliances
- Furniture
- Bedding and mattresses

On top of the gift cards there are additional discounts, rebates and selected bundle offers running across those categories. Not every item qualifies for every mechanic, which is where people get caught out at the till.

The furniture side is the sleeper

Storewide furniture savings go up to 30% off with qualifying spend. On a sofa and dining set, that is a materially bigger number than anything the gift card tier will hand you back.

Mattress and bedding deals are running alongside it. Mattresses are one of the few big-ticket categories where the margin is wide enough that sale pricing is genuinely different from list pricing, so the timing here is real rather than theatrical.

If you are furnishing a BTO, sequence it properly. Work out your total spend first, then check which gift card tier that lands you in, rather than buying piecemeal across three visits and missing every threshold.

Read the dates carefully

The promotion is advertised until 31 August 2026, but selected featured deals carry shorter windows, with some ending on 26 August. Different promotions inside the same sale run on different clocks.

Before you make the trip, confirm the end date of the specific item you want rather than assuming the storewide date applies. This is the single most common complaint after any Buy More Save More period.

How to work the gift card tiers

1. Add up everything you actually need over the next few months, not just today's purchase
2. Check which spend tier that total reaches
3. See whether adding one planned item pushes you into the next tier
4. Confirm the gift card expiry before you count it as savings
5. Ask whether the item also qualifies for a bundle or rebate, since they do not always stack

A gift card is only a discount if you were going to spend it anyway. If you have no plans to return to Harvey Norman this year, treat the \$300 as worth considerably less than \$300 and compare on the cash price instead.

Worth it or not

For furniture and mattresses, yes. The percentage off is doing the heavy lifting and the gift card is a bonus on top.

For a single small appliance, less so. You will not hit a meaningful tier, and a standalone air fryer is usually cheaper during a platform sale than during a department store promotion.

Terms and conditions apply, tiers vary by spend, and stock on featured lines moves quickly in the last week. Check the current offers on the Harvey Norman Singapore site before you head down.

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
