He Xiangning: Ink & Intent is one of the Singapore topics to have on your radar this week. He Xiangning: Ink & Intent runs at National Gallery Singapore until 23 August 2026, bringing more than 50 ink works and archival materials to Singapore.

The Quick Read

A cultural guide for readers looking for a substantial museum visit rather than a quick pop-up.

- Dates: 1 April to 23 August 2026.
- Venue: City Hall Wing, Level 4, Wu Guanzhong Gallery.
- The exhibition features over 50 ink works and archival materials.
- It is the largest travelling exhibition of He Xiangning's artworks from the He Xiangning Art Museum in Shenzhen.
- A General Admission ticket is required.

Who Should Pay Attention

This is most useful for readers who need a clear, local decision: whether to book, visit, budget, apply, compare or set aside time before the window passes. The practical details matter more than the headline, especially when venues, age suitability, minimum spend, ticketing or dates affect the plan.

Planning Notes

If you are heading down in a group, settle the transport route and timing first. For Suntec events, City Hall, Esplanade and Promenade are the usual MRT options. For Mandai, build in road travel time. For museum and dining visits, check admission, booking or reservation rules before leaving home.
