



HOME:     at Dempsey Hill, 450 Artists Unite for Charity Art Show

Description

What does “home” actually mean? This September, **450 artists** across Singapore, from young children to seasoned adults, offer their answers at **HOME: 2026**, a three-day community art exhibition at Dempsey Hill from 4 to 6 September 2026. Admission is free, and it is open to all.

Presented by Singapore arts education studio **Artgrain** in partnership with Dempsey Hill, the show gathers around 450 original artworks exploring memory, family, identity and the small everyday moments that quietly hold a life together. About a third of the artists are children and youth.

Art with a cause

Roughly half of the works will be available for purchase, with proceeds going to the **Children’s Cancer Foundation** and the **Singapore Cancer Society**. It is a fitting note for an exhibition built around community and giving back.

Voices across generations

Among the highlights is Lee Ker Peng’s oil painting *Ice Cream*, which traces a candid moment from a family trip to Hokkaido, a personal piece anchored in memory and grief. Also exhibiting is 16-year-old Myra Wee Hsin Shuen, recipient of the Business Times Budding Artist Award 2024, whose *Our Walk Home* took Gold at the 13th Art Prize 2024.
