Who Can Attend

HomeTeamNS Family Day is open to HomeTeamNS members and their immediate families. Non-members can also attend selected open sessions – check the HomeTeamNS website for the live list as the day approaches.

Sessions are mostly drop-in, but a handful of headline programmes require pre-registration.
