### Description

ICON Link@ClubStreet is Singapore's newest underground dining and lifestyle hub, and it's already turning heads among CBD workers and food lovers alike. Spanning nearly 20,000 square feet beneath the Mercure ICON Singapore City Centre at 8 Club Street, this air-conditioned underground space connects Chinatown and Telok Ayer through a sheltered walkway – making it the perfect lunchtime escape, rain or shine.

## What Is ICON Link@ClubStreet?

Tucked away at Basement 2 of the Mercure ICON Singapore City Centre hotel, ICON Link@ClubStreet is a vibrant underground stretch that brings together over 25 food outlets, retail shops, and wellness services. It sits right between the cultural richness of Chinatown and the bustling energy of the Central Business District (CBD), offering a curated mix of dining delights and retail experiences.

What truly sets this space apart is its seamless connectivity. With direct access to both **Telok Ayer MRT Station** (Downtown Line, Exit E) and **Chinatown MRT Station** (Exit H), you can pop in for a quick

bite or a leisurely meal without ever stepping into the sun or rain. If you enjoy exploring [dining options around Telok Ayer](#), this new hub is well worth adding to your list.

## Best Food Spots to Try at ICON Link@ClubStreet

With over 20 food and beverage outlets now open, there's something for every palate and budget. Here are some highlights worth checking out:

### Fun Toast - Old-School Breakfast Done Right

A Singapore heritage brand dating back to 1941, Fun Toast serves up one of the most affordable kaya butter toast sets in town at just \$5.90. Pair it with a cup of kopi for the ultimate traditional breakfast experience. You'll find them at unit #B2-20/21.

### Hazukido - Japanese-Style Croissants

Viennoiserie lovers, this one's for you. Hazukido offers Japanese-style croissants in more than 25 flavours, from the crowd-favourite Taro & Pudding (\$6.50) to the indulgent Queen Crab Truffle Cream (\$7.80). Find them at #B2-17.

### Super Ngon Vietnamese Noodle Cafe - Hearty Bowls of Pho

For a comforting bowl of Vietnamese beef noodle soup (\$10.90) made with rich beef bone broth, Super Ngon is the spot. Their freshly made rice noodles are the real deal. Located at #B2-24.

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## Mount Faber Nasi Lemak â?? A 1975 Legacy

This nasi lemak institution has been around since 1975 and continues to draw queues. Their Chicken Wing Set (\$6.80) is a bestseller, while the Lamb Curry Set (\$8) offers a deliciously different twist on the classic dish. Visit them at #B2-11.

## Amps Tea â?? By the Team Behind CHAGEE

If youâ??re a fan of CHAGEE, youâ??ll want to try Amps Tea, helmed by the same team. The Triple Peach Season Tea (\$6.20) is a refreshing pick, while the Da Hong Pao Latte (\$6.40) delivers a full-bodied oolong experience. Located at #B2-09.

## Beyond Food: Retail, Wellness, and Art

ICON Link@ClubStreet isnâ??t just about dining. The underground hub also features **Katia Verde**, a boutique selling beautiful Peranakan outfits and accessories, and **Hale TCM Clinic** offering acupuncture and cupping sessions for those in need of a midday wellness boost. Thereâ??s even a **Kairos Hair** salon for a quick trim between meetings.

Art lovers will appreciate the two large-scale murals by Singaporean artist **Belinda Low**, a self-taught painter known for capturing old-school Singapore scenes. One mural celebrates traditional Chinatown figures like samsui women and street tradespeople, while the other recreates a nostalgic street scene anchored by a lone musician. These striking artworks add a meaningful cultural layer to what could otherwise be just another underground mall.

If heritage and culture interest you, you might also enjoy reading about the [Singapore Heritage Festival](#), which celebrates many of the same precincts surrounding this new hub.

## How to Get to ICON Link@ClubStreet

Getting there is a breeze:

- **From Telok Ayer MRT Station** (Downtown Line): Take Exit E and walk straight ahead.
- **From Chinatown MRT Station**: Take Exit H.
- **From Mercure ICON Singapore City Centre**: Exit via the main sliding door, walk towards Cheers, turn right, and take the lift or escalator down to B2.
