



IKEA PS 2026 Singapore: Inflatable Knaback Chair, Giraffe Lamps And All The Launch Dates

Description

IKEA PS 2026 is finally landing in Singapore and it is exactly the kind of fun, slightly weird collection that lives rent-free in your head for weeks. From a green inflatable Knaback armchair to a giraffe-shaped lamp, the new range hits IKEA Alexandra and IKEA Tampines in-store on Wednesday, 27 May 2026, and goes live online and at all stores from Tuesday, 2 June.

If you are still nursing your Black Friday IKEA receipts, brace yourself. The PS series only drops every few years, and IKEA PS 2026 might be the most playful one yet. Here is your everything-you-need-to-know guide before queues form at Alexandra.

What Is IKEA PS 2026?

PS stands for "Post Scriptum" – IKEA's way of saying "p.s., we made these for fun." The range has been running since 1995 and has produced some of the brand's most iconic experimental pieces. Each PS launch is a limited-run capsule built around a theme, with designers given a longer leash than usual.

IKEA PS 2026 leans into playful, sculptural and downright cheeky – think furniture that blows, rocks and bends. Some pieces will look bizarre in a showroom but make perfect sense in a Singapore HDB living room that needs a personality injection.

The Headline Pieces To Look Out For

- **Knaback bright-green inflatable armchair:** A chair that literally inflates – yes, the seat back is a balloon. Surprisingly comfortable, very Instagrammable.
- **Rocking bench:** A bench that rocks like a porch swing, designed for hallway lounging
- **Giraffe lamp:** A standing lamp shaped like a giraffe – children's room or eccentric corner of your studio

- **Furry chair covers:** Throw-on covers that turn any IKEA chair into a fluffy beast
- **Toothy storage:** Cabinets with cartoonish smiles for kids's rooms
- **Bending lamp:** Flexible-armed lamp that bends into whatever angle you want

IKEA PS 2026 Launch Dates In Singapore

The phased rollout gives Alexandra and Tampines a head start. If you want first pick of the Knaback chair or the giraffe lamp, you will want to be at either store on Wednesday morning.

- **Wednesday, 27 May 2026:** In-store only at IKEA Alexandra and IKEA Tampines
- **Tuesday, 2 June 2026:** Online (ikea.com/sg) and all IKEA stores including IKEA Jurong
- **Stock:** Limited capsule - once it sells out, it is gone (no restock)

What Else Is On At IKEA This Period

Pair your PS 2026 haul with the ongoing May promotions. IKEA Family members are running discounts on selected home furnishing items in stores and online from 1 to 30 May 2026. There is also a \$300 IKEA voucher offer with free delivery for spends of \$2,000 and above, valid until 31 May.

If you are renovating a new BTO or sprucing up the Westies' favourite hangout - sorry, your HDB living room - the timing is shiok. Bundle the PS 2026 statement piece with practical Family-discounted basics like an EKET shelving wall or LILLESATER swivel armchair.

How To Beat The Queue

- Arrive at opening (IKEA Alexandra opens 10am, Tampines opens 10am)
- Head straight to the PS 2026 display zone - usually near the entrance Showroom
- Bring an IKEA Family card (free to sign up) for member-only pricing on other items
- Use the Click-and-Collect option from 2 June if you cannot make it Wednesday
- Follow IKEA Singapore on Instagram (@IKEASingapore) for restock surprises

Is IKEA PS 2026 Worth The Hype?

Honestly, yes - but with one caveat. PS pieces are statement furniture, not workhorses. The Knaback inflatable chair will not replace your daily lounge. The giraffe lamp is delightfully ridiculous but will not light a study desk well.

Treat IKEA PS 2026 like a capsule fashion drop. Pick the one piece that makes you smile, throw it into a corner that needs character, and let it earn its keep through compliments at house parties. See you at Alexandra on Wednesday morning.
