



interweave At Esplanade Pairs Music And Dance In A Free 30-Minute Set

Description

[interweave](#) is one of the more compact eXchange 2026 choices for a midweek arts stop.

The free Esplanade Concourse programme runs on 17 and 18 June 2026, with performances at 7pm and 7.45pm each night.

What To Expect

The official listing presents interweave as a music-and-dance programme by Jack and Ray. The short 30-minute format makes it closer to an encounter than a full-length theatre evening.

That can be a strength. Viewers can watch how sound, motion and timing interact without needing to understand a long narrative arc.

- Dates: 17 and 18 June 2026.
- Times: 7pm and 7.45pm.
- Duration: 30 minutes with no intermission.
- Venue: Esplanade Concourse.
- Admission: free.

Best Audience Fit

This is suitable for someone who wants to sample contemporary performance in a low-pressure setting. It is also a practical date-night or after-work stop if you are already near the Marina Bay area.

Families with older children can use it as a short introduction to how music and dance can be built together, but younger children may need a clearer story-based programme.

How To Plan

Since the performances are close together, choose one show rather than trying to hover between both. Arrive a few minutes early, especially if you prefer sitting near the performance area.

The Concourse format also means ambient movement around the venue is part of the experience. If you want a quieter view, pick the earlier show and avoid treating the space like a late-arrival standing room.
