



Into The Ocean: Journey Beneath At ArtScience Museum Opens 6 June

Description

Into The Ocean: Journey Beneath opens at ArtScience Museum on 6 June 2026, giving families a June holiday exhibition that is more immersive than a straightforward science display. The show runs until 1 November 2026 at Basement 2 Galleries and is presented in collaboration with OceanX.

The official description frames it as a descent through the depths of the sea, from sunlit surface waters to darker ocean environments. ArtScience Museum calls it an “immersive” experience, a word that points to a more participatory journey rather than a row of objects behind glass.

Why Families May Like It



The exhibition takes visitors from surface waters into deeper ocean environments.

Ocean exhibitions tend to work well for mixed-age groups because the subject is easy to enter. Children recognise sea creatures and underwater worlds; adults can connect the experience to climate, biodiversity, technology and exploration. That gives the exhibition room to be both visual and educational.

The OceanX collaboration is also useful context. OceanX is known for ocean exploration and media work, so the show is likely to lean into the drama of going below the surface. For children who enjoy documentaries, deep-sea creatures or aquariums, this may be easier to sell than a quieter gallery visit.

Because the exhibition opens on 6 June, families should expect stronger demand in the first school-holiday weeks. If your child gets overwhelmed in crowds, a weekday morning after opening week may be more comfortable than the first weekend.

Tickets And Timing

Marina Bay Sands lists Singapore resident tickets from S\$19.50 for adults and S\$16.50 for concessions, with tourist tickets from S\$22 for adults and S\$18 for concessions. Ticket prices and offers can change, so check the official page before booking.



The show is created in collaboration with OceanX and makes its world premiere in Singapore.

The museum's regular opening hours are 10am to 7pm from Sunday to Thursday and 10am to 9pm on Friday and Saturday. Last entry is listed at 6pm on shorter days and 8.15pm on Friday and Saturday.
