



Isetan NEX Closing-Down Sale: Up to 80% Off Kitchenware, Home Appliances, and More (Ends 26 April 2026)

After 15 years at Serangoon's NEX shopping mall, Isetan is closing its doors for good and the farewell discounts are massive. The Isetan NEX Household Department on Level 3 is running an "Everything Must Go" clearance sale with discounts of up to 80% off kitchenware, home appliances, cookware, and everyday household essentials.

What Is on Sale?

The "Any 2 for \$60" Bundle Deal

One of the standout promotions is the "Any 2 for \$60" bundle, where you can mix and match freely across brands like Tefal, WMF, Hario, Endo, and Midea. With over 45 products included in this offer, it is essentially a treasure hunt to find the best combination.

For example, you could pair a Tefal non-stick pan with a WMF kitchen tool set, or grab two Hario coffee accessories for the price of one regular item. The value here is excellent, especially if you are willing to spend some time browsing through the selection.

Pro tip: Go with a list of what you need, but also be open to discovering deals on items you had not planned to buy. The "Any 2 for \$60" display is scattered across the department, so do a full lap before deciding on your picks.

Practical Tips for Shopping the Sale

Go on a weekday if you can. The sale gets crowded on weekends, especially now that word has spread on social media. Weekday afternoons tend to be the quietest, giving you more space to browse and better access to the remaining stock.

Arrive early for the best selection. New stock is not being replenished — once items are gone, they are gone for good. If you have your eye on a specific appliance or cookware set, do not wait until the last week of the sale.

Bring your own bags. As with most clearance sales, packaging may be minimal. A reusable shopping bag will make it easier to carry your purchases home, especially if you are taking the MRT from Serangoon station (which is conveniently connected to NEX).

Check items carefully before purchasing. Clearance items are typically sold as-is, and returns may be limited. Give appliances a visual inspection and check that all parts and accessories are included in the box before paying.

Compare prices on the spot. While the discounts are genuine, it is always worth doing a quick price check on your phone. Some items may be available at similar prices online, especially during regular e-commerce sales. That said, the "Any 2 for \$60" bundles are genuinely hard to beat.
