



Jiin Omakase Opens At Shaw Centre: What Diners Should Know

Description

Jiin Omakase has opened at Shaw Centre, adding another Japanese counter-dining option to Orchard under the Les Amis Group Japanese Collective. The restaurant focuses on premium seafood, seasonal produce and omotenashi, the Japanese idea of attentive hospitality.

For diners, the useful question is whether this is a special-occasion omakase or a more approachable fine-dining stop. The setting at 1 Scotts Road makes it easy to combine with an Orchard visit, but the format still suits diners who are comfortable leaving the menu in the chef's hands.

What To Expect

Head Chef Sakamoto Mitsutaka leads the counter with guidance from Group Executive Chef Saito Makoto. The restaurant's own description points to premium seafood and seasonal expression rather than a fixed a la carte meal.

That means guests should expect menu changes based on ingredients, availability and the kitchen's sequence for the day. Omakase works best when you are open about allergies and preferences before the meal starts.

Jiin Omakase is at Shaw Centre #01-11, a convenient Orchard address near the existing Les Amis Group cluster. Reserve ahead if you want a weekend slot, and give the restaurant dietary information early because counter-dining menus are harder to adjust at the last minute.
