



Five Family-Friendly Short Trips Within Six Hours For June 2026 School Holidays

1. Phuket, Thailand

- **Flight time:** Approximately 2 hours
- **Best for:** Beach and light adventure
- **What to do:** Bangtao Beach for the under-10s, Phi Phi day boats for the older kids, Phuket Old Town for an evening stroll
- **Budget watch:** Mid-range family resort packages from S\$1,200 per family for a four-night stay

2. Bali, Indonesia

- **Flight time:** Approximately 2.5 hours
- **Best for:** Mixed beach-and-culture itineraries
- **What to do:** Nusa Dua for safe beach swimming, Ubud for rice terrace walks, the elephant safari park (book official-only operators)
- **Budget watch:** Nusa Dua family villas from S\$200 per night

3. Bangkok, Thailand

- **Flight time:** Approximately 2.5 hours
- **Best for:** Older kids who like cities

- **What to do:** Chatuchak Weekend Market, Siam Park City, riverside dinner cruises
- **Budget watch:** Sukhumvit family hotels from S\$120 per night

4. Krabi, Thailand

- **Flight time:** Approximately 2 hours
- **Best for:** Quieter beach families
- **What to do:** Ao Nang resorts for the under-10s, Railay Beach long-tail boat trips, the Emerald Pool day trip
- **Budget watch:** Beachfront family rooms from S\$150 per night

5. Penang, Malaysia

- **Flight time:** Approximately 1.5 hours (or 6 hours by car or coach for the adventure version)
- **Best for:** Food-led short breaks
- **What to do:** George Town heritage walks, Penang Hill funicular, Entopia butterfly farm
- **Budget watch:** Heritage hotels from S\$120 per night

Booking Strategy For June 2026 School Holiday Short Trips

Lock flights for the second half of June if your kids do not need to be home for the last week â?? fares dip 15 to 20 per cent. Use cards promo programmes from DBS and UOB for hotel bookings to stack savings.

And do not forget travel insurance â?? June rainstorms across Southeast Asia have been heavier in 2026 than the five-year average. Better to be paid out for a delay than to be shag at an airport for nothing.
