



Kiddy Palace Lot One Closing Down Sale: Storewide Deals Before 13 September

Description

If you have been putting off restocking the diaper bag or hunting for a birthday present, the **Kiddy Palace Lot One closing down sale** is the lobang to bookmark this week. The outlet is clearing stock storewide, right up until 13 September 2026. It is one of the better times all year to pick up baby essentials, toys and kidsâ?? products without paying full price.

Kiddy Palace has been a familiar name for Singapore parents for three decades, and the Lot One store at Choa Chu Kang is now winding down. That means shelves are being cleared, and the savings reflect it. Families who are managing multiple purchases a year for a growing child will want to plan a visit sooner rather than later.

Whatâ??s on at the Kiddy Palace Lot One Closing Down Sale

The sale covers a wide spread: bottle feeding and breastfeeding accessories, bath and skincare items, nursery furniture, strollers and car seats, and of course toys for every age group. Regular-priced items are typically discounted, while nett-priced products see a smaller markdown, so it is worth comparing before you commit to a big-ticket item like a stroller or car seat.

- Baby essentials: feeding bottles, sterilisers, skincare and bath products
- Nursery items: cots, playmats and safety accessories
- Toys: educational sets, ride-ons and outdoor play items
- Travel gear: strollers, car seats and carriers

Because this is a closing sale rather than a seasonal promotion, stock is not being replenished. Sizes and colours for popular items like scooters and ride-on toys tend to move fast, so visiting in the first week gives you first pick rather than the leftovers.

Where and When

The sale runs at Kiddy Palace, Lot One Mall, #02-08/09, Singapore 689812, from 10.30am to 9.30pm daily, now until 13 September 2026. The outlet is a short walk from Choa Chu Kang MRT and bus interchange, so it is easy to fold into an existing errand run rather than a special trip.

Parents juggling multiple kidsâ?? milestones this year, from a friendâ??s baby shower to a nephewâ??s birthday, may want to treat this as a one-stop shopping trip. Buying a few gifts or restocking essentials in a single visit is where the savings really add up, especially on items families were going to purchase anyway.

Worth Noting Before You Go

Since this is a closing down promotion, expect the usual caveats: all sales are likely final, and exchanges may not be offered the way they would at a full-price outlet. It is also worth bringing a rough shopping list, since browsing a clearance floor without one can mean overspending on things you did not plan for.

If Choa Chu Kang is out of the way, Kiddy Palace still operates other outlets islandwide, though this particular closing sale and its pricing only applies at Lot One. Families who have been meaning to switch strollers or upgrade a car seat before a long-haul flight should treat the next two weeks as the window to do it.

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
