Mandai Action for Wildlife Programme gives schools a conservation-focused pathway for students to study Singapore's native wildlife and propose ways for people and wildlife to coexist in an urban landscape.

What The Programme Focuses On

Mandai Wildlife Group frames the programme around native wildlife, urban conservation and student-led problem solving. That makes it useful for schools looking for environmental education that connects directly to Singapore rather than only to distant habitats.

How Schools Might Use It

Teachers can anchor projects around species awareness, habitat pressure, human-wildlife encounters, public communication and practical conservation ideas. The strongest use is likely a project brief with field learning, research and a presentation outcome.
