

Oh and Anchorpoint looks different from how we remember it to be. Apparently it went through a revamp.






Really quite a lot of effort to set this up.








Here are what is to be used for the event.



Although it looks intimidating due to the set up, it is not something that is so daunting that young children cannot undertake.












Yes, it is applicable for almost all ages. These children were very young but were thoroughly engaged throughout.

Do not worry. Donâ??t need to draw and paint to that standard.











Hamimahâ??s daughter drawing her.

Guess which was done by Hamimah and which was done by her daughter.









We get a set of cards for the event.






The flowers were used to decorate the cards.
