



## Misaki Japanese Restaurant Reopens At MBFC: What To Know Before Booking

### Description

Misaki Japanese Restaurant has reopened at Marina Bay Financial Centre, giving CBD diners a familiar Japanese name in a new setting. The restaurant's official website states that it is now operating at MBFC Tower 3, #01-01, with lunch from Monday to Friday and dinner from Monday to Saturday.

This is the sort of reopening that matters most to office workers, client-lunch planners and omakase regulars who want a central address without turning dinner into a cross-island journey. Misaki's own positioning is clear: true Japanese cuisine, private rooms, and omakase-style creations led by Executive Chef Khor-san.

### The New Location

The address is 12 Marina Boulevard, Marina Bay Financial Centre Tower 3, #01-01. That puts Misaki in the middle of the financial district, close to Downtown, Marina Bay and Raffles Place work crowds. The move gives the restaurant a practical advantage for weekday lunches and after-work dinners.

The official hours are Monday to Friday lunch from 11.30am to 3pm, with last order at 2.30pm, and dinner from 6pm to 10pm, with last order at 9.45pm. Saturday is dinner-only, while Sunday is closed. Those hours make it more of a planned booking than a spontaneous late-night stop.

## What The Restaurant Is Built Around

Misaki describes omakase as entrusting the meal to the chef, with seasonal creations served in a cosy private-dining setting. That tells you how to approach the restaurant. It is better for a focused meal than for a quick, noisy group catch-up where nobody is paying attention to the food.

The website also highlights private rooms, which can matter for business dining. In the CBD, a restaurant that can handle client conversation without shouting across a table has a different role from a casual sushi counter.

## How To Plan A CBD Meal

For lunch, book with timing discipline. MBFC lunches can become tight if you are moving between towers or returning to meetings. Confirm whether your group is ordering a set, omakase or a la carte before arrival so the meal does not drift.

For dinner, the restaurant is better treated as the main plan rather than a pre-event stop. If you are choosing omakase, leave enough time for pacing. A meal built around seasonal courses loses some of its point if everyone is watching the clock.

## Mei Chua's Dining Read

Misaki's appeal is not trendiness; it is reliability, location and a quieter style of Japanese dining. That can be exactly what CBD diners need when the week is full and the meal has to feel composed rather than performative.

I would book it for a business lunch, a small birthday dinner or a catch-up where the food should lead the room. If you want a loud, casual izakaya energy, this is probably not the first match. If you want a polished Japanese meal near the office, the MBFC move makes sense.

## Booking Notes

The official site lists enquiries and reservations by phone at +65 6443 1187. Because the restaurant highlights private rooms, call ahead if privacy or room configuration matters. Also check current menu availability if you are booking for seasonal specials.

For guests arriving by MRT, Downtown and Raffles Place are both practical depending on your starting point. Drivers should factor in CBD parking and peak-hour traffic around Marina Boulevard.

## Practical Details To Keep In Mind

Misaki Japanese Restaurant MBFC is easiest to assess when you turn the headline into a real calendar or budget decision. Start with the exact date, place, price or eligibility rule, then decide whether it fits your household, work week, travel plan or buying timeline.
