



My Little Chingay Float Exhibition: Free SCCC Family Guide

Description

My Little Chingay Float Exhibition opens at Singapore Chinese Cultural Centre on 20 June 2026, giving families a free bilingual pop-up built around the colourful world of the Chingay Parade.

The exhibition is co-presented with the People's Association and runs at SCCC Concourse, Level 1, from 20 June to 20 September 2026. Daily hours are listed as 10am to 6pm.

What Families Can Expect

SCCC describes the exhibition as a giant Chingay storybook pop-up that brings the parade to life for both parents and children. The content is in English and Chinese, which makes it useful for bilingual family outings and school-holiday learning.

- Venue: SCCC Concourse, Level 1.
- Admission: free.
- Languages: English and Mandarin.
- Suitable for: all ages.

Why It Works As A Short Outing

Because the venue is the concourse rather than a ticketed theatre, this is easy to add before lunch, after a nearby CBD errand or as part of a weekend city route. It is also a low-risk option for children who may not sit through a full performance.

The theme gives parents a way to talk about creativity, community and multicultural celebration through Chingay, which is more approachable for younger children than a conventional heritage panel display.

Planning Notes

The exhibition runs for three months, so there is no need to rush opening weekend unless you want to be among the first visitors. Weekday mornings should be calmer for families with toddlers or grandparents.

SCCC is near Tanjong Pagar, making public transport the simplest route. If driving, check parking availability around major CBD meal times.
