



OPPO Find X9 Ultra Launches Globally on 21 April: Dual 200MP Hasselblad Cameras, 10x Optical Zoom From S\$1,899

Description

The OPPO Find X9 Ultra is set to make its highly anticipated global debut on 21 April 2026, marking a historic milestone as the first-ever Ultra model from OPPO to launch outside China. With a groundbreaking quad-camera system co-engineered with Hasselblad, the Snapdragon 8 Elite Gen 5 chipset, and a massive 7,050mAh battery, this flagship is shaping up to be one of the most formidable camera phones of the year.

The Find X9 and [Find X9 Pro are already available in Singapore](#), priced at S\$1,299 and S\$1,599 respectively. The Ultra variant is expected to arrive in international markets, including Singapore, shortly after the global launch event.

A Camera System Built for Photography Enthusiasts

The headline feature of the OPPO Find X9 Ultra is undoubtedly its camera system. Developed in partnership with Hasselblad, the quad-camera array is headlined by a 200MP Sony LYT-901 main sensor that rivals a 1-inch sensor in light-gathering capability.

What truly sets the Find X9 Ultra apart is its dual periscope telephoto setup. A 200MP OmniVision OV52A sensor sits behind a 3x periscope zoom lens on a large 1/1.28-inch sensor, delivering stunning portrait and mid-range telephoto shots. A second 50MP Samsung ISOCELL JNL periscope camera handles 10x optical zoom duties, utilising OPPO's Quintuple Prism Reflection Structure that folds light five times to achieve true 10x magnification without adding bulk.

Rounding out the rear camera system is a 50MP Sony LYT-600 ultrawide shooter, while a 50MP front-facing camera handles selfies and video calls.

Flagship Performance Under the Hood

Powering the Find X9 Ultra is Qualcomm's latest Snapdragon 8 Elite Gen 5 chipset, paired with up to 16GB of LPDDR5X RAM and up to 1TB of UFS 4.1 storage. The 6.82-inch AMOLED display features 2K resolution with a smooth 120Hz refresh rate, ensuring a premium visual experience for everything from gaming to streaming.

The 7,050mAh battery is among the largest ever fitted in a flagship smartphone, and it supports 100W wired fast charging to get you back to full power quickly. The device runs ColorOS 16 based on Android 16, bringing the latest AI-powered features and interface improvements.

Design and Colour Options

The OPPO Find X9 Ultra will launch in at least two striking colourways: Canyon Orange and Tundra Umber. The Canyon Orange option is a bold, warm-toned finish that has drawn comparisons to Apple's popular Cosmic Orange on the iPhone 17 Pro, while the Tundra Umber offers a more understated, earthy aesthetic. A white variant may also be in the pipeline, though this has not been officially confirmed.

The device features a prominent circular Hasselblad-branded camera module on the rear, housing the quad-camera system. Despite the ambitious camera hardware, OPPO has managed to keep the phone relatively sleek thanks to the innovative quintuple prism periscope design.

Singapore Pricing and Availability

While official Singapore pricing for the OPPO Find X9 Ultra has not been confirmed, the device is expected to be priced from approximately S\$1,899 based on the positioning of the existing Find X9 series in the market. The standard Find X9 retails at S\$1,299 and the Find X9 Pro at S\$1,599, suggesting the Ultra will command a premium.

The global launch event is scheduled for 21 April 2026, with international availability expected to follow within weeks. In Singapore, the Find X9 series is available through the [OPPO Online Store](#), Shopee, Lazada, and authorised retailers.

The combination of the Snapdragon 8 Elite Gen 5, a massive 7,050mAh battery, and 100W fast charging also ensures that the Find X9 Ultra is not just a camera phone – it is a well-rounded flagship that can hold its own against the Samsung Galaxy S26 Ultra and iPhone 17 Pro Max.
