



Orchid Extravaganza at Flower Dome: Catch It Before 10 August

Description

If you have been meaning to visit, the **Orchid Extravaganza Flower Dome** display is entering its final stretch and closes on 10 August 2026. This year's edition, themed "Rhythm of the Rainforest", celebrates the heritage and biodiversity of Indonesia's regions with a lush Balinese-inspired setting. More than 7,000 orchids fill the Flower Field, from rare native species to show-stopping hybrids. It is the perfect air-conditioned escape from the July heat, and a shiok spot for photos.

The display sits inside the Flower Dome, the world's largest glass greenhouse by Guinness World Records. Entry to the Orchid Extravaganza is included with your Flower Dome ticket. Here is everything you need to plan the visit before it ends.

Orchid Extravaganza Flower Dome: what to expect

Expect towering Balinese temple gates, terraced rice-field landscaping and orchids cascading in every colour. The scenography is built around Indonesia's cultural regions, so it feels like a short holiday without leaving Marina Bay. Weekday mornings are the calmest, while weekends draw the crowds. Bring a light layer, as the dome is kept at a cool 23°C to 25°C.

Ticket prices

Flower Dome tickets already include the Orchid Extravaganza, and Singapore residents pay less. All prices are in SGD and inclusive of GST.

- **Flower Dome (Singapore Resident):** \$12 adult, \$8 senior (60+), \$8 child (3-12)
- **Flower Dome (Non-Resident):** from a higher tier; check at purchase
- **Flower Dome + Cloud Forest (Jurassic World: The Experience), Resident:** \$34 adult, \$29 senior, \$26 child

- **Proof of residency** may be required at purchase or entry

Visiting details and hours

- **Where:** Flower Dome, Gardens by the Bay, 18 Marina Gardens Drive, Singapore 018953
- **Runs until:** Monday, 10 August 2026
- **Opening hours:** daily 9.00am to 9.00pm (last admission 8.30pm)
- **Suggested time:** about 1 hour for the Flower Dome
- **Maintenance closure:** Flower Dome will be closed on 17 August 2026 (after this display ends)
- **Free guided tours:** selected August Saturdays, gather at the "ASK Me!" points

- Wear comfortable shoes and bring a cardigan for the cool dome.
- Buy tickets online in advance to skip the counter.
