



Our Joyous Vesak Marks Thekchen Choling's Silver Jubilee Year

Description

Our Joyous Vesak gives families a structured way to observe Vesak at Thekchen Choling Singapore. The temple frames this year's celebration around Vesak 2570 and its own Silver Jubilee, marking 25 years of activity in Singapore.

The observance honours Shakyamuni Buddha's birth, enlightenment and parinirvana. For parents, it is also a chance to introduce children to temple etiquette, offerings, blessings and the idea that a public holiday can carry reflection rather than only outings.

What Families Can Notice

Thekchen Choling's Vesak page lists a mix of devotional and community activities, including pujas, blessing sessions and familiar Vesak rituals. These are useful for families because children can connect abstract ideas such as compassion and gratitude to visible acts: lighting, offerings, chanting and moving through temple spaces respectfully.

The Silver Jubilee framing adds another layer. Rather than treating the visit as a one-off holiday stop, families can talk about how religious and community institutions stay rooted in a neighbourhood over time.

Before You Go

Dress modestly, keep voices low in prayer areas and let younger children know that some moments are for quiet observation. If you are unfamiliar with a ritual, watching first is usually better than rushing in.

Families planning a full day can pair the temple visit with a simple nearby meal and keep the schedule light. The practical benefit is a calmer, more respectful visit where children can ask questions after each ritual instead of being rushed through the hall. - Use covered shoulders and comfortable footwear.
