What to Expect at the Festival

Reog Ponorogo and Wayang Krucil Performance

One of the weekendâ??s most spectacular highlights is the **Reog Ponorogo and Wayang Krucil Performance by Pesona Nusantara**, featuring the iconic *Dadak Merak* â?? a towering lion-peacock mask weighing up to 50 kilograms â?? alongside a rare wooden puppet theatre performance from Java. This is a genuine once-in-a-while opportunity to witness one of Indonesiaâ??s most dramatic traditional art forms in Singapore.

Pride of the Peacock! Interactive Family Theatre

Families with young children should head to Level 2 for **Pride of the Peacock!**, an interactive in-gallery theatrical experience that takes visitors on a journey through the exhibition alongside Pat the Peacock and his friend Lilly. It's designed to be engaging for younger visitors while still being meaningful for adults.

Peranakan Association Singapore Programmes

The Peranakan Association Singapore has collaborated on a rich array of community programmes across the weekend. These include sharing sessions on the *kebaya* and Peranakan beadwork, guided tours exploring the peacock in Peranakan culture, live performances and hands-on craft activities. There's also a museum-wide Peacock Passport giveaway running across the weekend.
