



Permata 1-for-1 Halal Buffet: Nusantara Feast at Gedung Kuning From \$22 a Head Until 31 August 2026

Description

If you have been hunting for a **Permata 1-for-1 halal buffet** deal this National Day season, this is the lobang to bookmark right now. Permata Singapore, the halal-certified Nusantara buffet inside the historic yellow mansion Gedung Kuning in Kampong Glam, is running a 1-for-1 buffet promotion until 31 August 2026. With more than 50 dishes across live stations, it is one of the most shiok halal buffet spreads in town for the price. Queues are already building over the long weekend, so read this before you book.

The Permata 1-for-1 halal buffet: what you actually pay

The headline is simple: buy one buffet, get one free, so two diners share a single adult price. That effectively halves the bill, which is where the real value sits. Here is the breakdown before GST and service charge:

- **Lunch buffet:** \$44++ per adult (U.P. \$88++) â?? about \$22++ a head with 1-for-1.
- **Dinner buffet:** \$54++ per adult (U.P. \$108++) â?? about \$27++ a head with 1-for-1.
- **Promotion validity:** until 31 August 2026, while the National Day showcase runs.

For a full-service halal spread in a heritage setting, that is a genuinely atas experience at hawker-adjacent value. Do note the ++ means GST and service charge are added on top. Reservations are strongly recommended because walk-in slots are limited during the promotion.

Here is what to order at the buffet

The current buffet showcase is themed around the flavours of the Lion City, spanning Indonesia, Singapore, Malaysia, Brunei and Thailand. Chef Mel Dean, Permata's Culinary Director, leans into nostalgic Nusantara dishes done properly. Pace yourself and prioritise these stations:

- **Meat grill station:** slow-grilled meats carved to order, plus satay and skewers.
- **Fresh seafood on ice:** prawns, mussels, clams, scallops and more.
- **Nusantara mains:** rendang, sambal-forward dishes and classic kampung recipes.
- **Noodle and salad stations:** ulam, kerabu and made-to-order noodles.
- **Desserts:** traditional kuih and regional sweets to close the meal.

Permata is a halal-certified Nusantara restaurant, so the entire buffet is halal and suitable for Muslim diners and mixed groups alike. That makes it an easy choice for family gatherings, buka puasa-style feasts and office makan sessions where everyone can eat together. As certification status can be renewed periodically, it is always worth confirming when you reserve. For a heritage-rich halal buffet, few spots match the setting here.

Everything you need to know before you go

- **Address:** Gedung Kuning, 73 Sultan Gate, Singapore 198497.
- **Opening hours:** 12pm–2.30pm and 6pm–9.30pm daily.
- **Nearest MRT:** Bugis, then a short walk into Kampong Glam.
- **Reservations:** book ahead, especially for dinner and weekend slots.
- **Best for:** family celebrations, halal buffet lovers and heritage diners.

With the 1-for-1 offer ending 31 August 2026, this one will not last long. If you have been meaning to try a proper halal Nusantara buffet, this is the window. Gather your kakis, make the booking, and go hungry. For more places to eat, see our food guides below.

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
