



Pink Dot 18 Singapore: 27 June 2026 Save-The-Date And Entry Notes

Description

Pink Dot 18 now has a clear save-the-date: Pink Dot SG's official 2026 banner lists 27 June 2026. The banner uses the Pink Dot 18 mark and the familiar line supporting the freedom to love, signalling that the annual community gathering is moving into its next edition.

The official homepage is still light on the full 2026 programme, so the practical thing to do now is separate confirmed information from routine planning. The date is confirmed on the official banner, while Pink Dot's FAQ remains the useful source for Hong Lim Park Speakers' Corner access rules and what attendees should prepare.

Entry Rules To Remember

Pink Dot's FAQ states that, in accordance with Hong Lim Park Speakers' Corner regulations and the Public Order Act, only Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents are allowed to enter the barricaded part of the event space. The FAQ also asks attendees to bring ID for entry.

Accepted ID examples on the FAQ include Digital NRIC on the SingPass app, physical driving licence, Digital Driving Licence on SingPass, Singapore Passport and physical School ID EZ-Link Card for children over seven. Children under seven must be accompanied by Singapore citizens or PRs.

- Official save-the-date: 27 June 2026.
- Event mark: Pink Dot 18.
- Entry rule: barricaded event space is for Singapore citizens and PRs.
- ID: bring NRIC, SingPass digital ID, driving licence, passport or eligible school ID where applicable.

What To Plan Now

The full 2026 programme is not the part to over-read yet. Previous FAQ notes describe Pink Dot as a rain-or-shine outdoor event and tell attendees to wear comfortable pink clothing, bring refillable water bottles and carry a pink torch with fresh batteries for the formation and light-up.

Those are sensible preparations even before the complete Pink Dot 18 running order is published. If you are planning with family or friends, settle who can enter the barricaded area, who may need to remain outside and where your group will meet before and after the event.

Pink Dot remains one of Singapore's most recognisable community gatherings around LGBTQ+ visibility and support. The 2026 date gives supporters time to plan leave, transport, volunteer availability and Pride-month activities around the final Saturday in June.
