



Popeyes Singapore Launches 3 Promotions from 20 April 2026: \$15 Full Bucket Set, 1-for-1 Midnight Crunch Buddy Combo and 1-for-1 Middy Hainanese Fragrant Rice Bowls

Description

Popeyes Singapore is stacking its promotional calendar for the week ahead, with three separate promotions running from 20 April 2026 that together blanket lunch, the afternoon lull and the post-midnight crowd. Whether you are heading to the food court after work, ducking in for a late supper near the MRT, or feeding four hungry friends at a shared table, there is a flagship deal with your name on it as long as you turn up within the right hours.

Here is the full breakdown of the three Popeyes Singapore promotions launching on 20 April 2026, including what you pay, the hours, the participating outlets and the exclusions you should know before you queue.

At a glance: all three Popeyes promotions from 20 April 2026

There are three distinct deals, each with its own dates and time windows. Note that two of the three promotions end on 24 April 2026 (Friday), so the window is tight if you want all three, you effectively have a five-day overlap from Monday to Friday before the Chicken Week bucket carries on alone through the weekend.

- **Popeyes Chicken Week Full Bucket Set** at \$15 (U.P. \$30.60), 20 to 26 April 2026, daily 12pm to 9pm.
- **Popeyes Midnight Crunch 1-for-1 Midnight Buddy Combo** at \$10.30, 20 to 24 April 2026, Monday to Friday, 10pm to 2am.
- **Popeyes Middy Buddy Combo** at \$9.90 (U.P. \$19.80), 20 to 24 April 2026, daily 1pm to 5pm.

All three promotions are valid for dine-in and takeaway only, and all three exclude the Changi Airport Terminal 1 outlet. None of the three deals can be used in conjunction with other promotions, discounts or privileges.

The Chicken Week offer is the headline number and the one most families will zero in on. For \$15 â?? just under half the usual \$30.60 price tag â?? diners get the Full Bucket Set, which comprises four pieces of Popeyesâ?? Signature Chicken, three Buttermilk Tenders and a large drink. That is a 50% saving off the usual price, and enough protein to stretch to three adults or a group of kids.

What makes this deal stand out is not just the raw discount but the hours. Popeyes has set the window at a generous 12pm to 9pm daily, which straddles lunch, the 3pm tea crowd, dinner and the late-dinner walk-ins from 8 to 9pm. The promotion runs every day from 20 April (Monday) through 26 April (Sunday) â?? a full seven days â?? giving you roughly 63 hours of eligibility across the week.

What is actually in the Full Bucket Set?

Popeyes builds the Full Bucket Set around its Signature Chicken â?? bone-in, hand-battered and buttermilk-marinated for at least 12 hours. Four pieces of Signature Chicken typically gives you a mix of breast, thigh, wing and drumstick, which is enough to spread across two or three people without arguments over who gets what.

The Buttermilk Tenders â?? three pieces â?? are the white-meat boneless option, breaded in the same style but easier to eat on the go. You also get one large drink to share (the drink tap rules apply at dine-in). At \$15, the per-piece cost works out to just over \$2.10 per piece of chicken (ignoring the drink), which is well under Popeyesâ?? a-la-carte pricing.

Who is this for, and when should you go?

This is a sharing deal. A solo diner will not finish seven pieces of chicken in a single sitting, so it makes the most sense for pairs, families or small groups. The 12pm to 9pm window means you can turn it into a Saturday brunch, a weekday lunch for the office, or a last-minute takeaway dinner after work before the offer closes at 9pm.

The value is particularly sharp if you are used to ordering delivery â?? Popeyes delivery fees and markups typically push a comparable bucket well above \$30, so dining in or doing a takeaway run will pocket you the full saving.

The fine print

The Full Bucket Set at \$15 is valid for dine-in and takeaway only. The Changi Airport T1 outlet is excluded, so travellers transiting or sending off family at T1 will not be able to claim the deal there. The promotion is not valid in conjunction with any other promotions, discounts or privileges â?? meaning you cannot stack it with app vouchers, delivery discounts or student promos.

For the late-night shift workers, after-party diners and supper regulars, Popeyes has kept its Midnight Crunch format going for another round – this time with a new configuration. From 20 April (Monday) to 24 April (Friday), the 1-for-1 Midnight Buddy Combo drops to \$10.30, which buys you two Mac Attack Bowls and two Large Drinks. The effective per-person cost is \$5.15, which is extraordinary for sit-down fried chicken in Singapore at that hour.

The Midnight Crunch operates on a compressed weeknight schedule: 10pm to 2am, Monday through Friday. That means the last eligible order for dining in falls just before 2am on the morning of Saturday, 25 April 2026 – after which the clock resets and the promotion is over.

What is a Mac Attack Bowl?

The Mac Attack Bowl is Popeyes Singapore’s mac-and-cheese-anchored bowl format, typically layered with shredded chicken, a cheese sauce and crispy toppings over the mac base. For late-night eating – when most diners want something substantive but not so heavy it keeps them awake – a bowl-format carbohydrate-protein combo hits the right notes.

Pair the two bowls with two Large Drinks and you have enough for two people to refuel after a late shift, a concert, or a study session near one of the participating outlets.

Midnight Crunch participating outlets

Unlike the Chicken Week bucket, the Midnight Crunch is restricted to a specific list of 12 Popeyes outlets that are set up to trade past midnight. If your usual Popeyes is not on this list, you will need to travel to one that is. The participating outlets for the 20 to 24 April 2026 Midnight Crunch are:

- Kinex Mall
- East Village Mall
- ESR BizPark
- Jurong Point
- The Rail Mall
- Crown Centre (excluding 14 April, Tuesday)
- Pan Pacific Orchard
- Woodlands MRT
- Northpoint City
- The Seletar Mall
- AMK Hub
- Heartland Kovan Mall

You need to order at the counter to enjoy the 1-for-1 price – delivery and app orders are not part of this specific promotion. As with the bucket deal, it is dine-in or takeaway only, not valid with other discounts, and the Changi Airport T1 outlet is excluded (not that T1 runs a 2am shift anyway).

Why the counter-only rule matters

Counter-only deals are Popeyes's way of capping the number of redemptions and keeping kitchen throughput manageable during a quiet shift. It also means the deal is effectively "while stocks last" if the outlet runs out of Mac Attack Bowl components at 1am, the deal is over for the night. If you are making a special trip, go earlier rather than later in the 10pm to 2am window.

The third promotion is the one aimed squarely at the 3pm slump. The Midday Buddy Combo delivers two of Popeyes's new Hainanese Fragrant Rice Kick Bowls plus two Large Drinks at a combined price of \$9.90 — down from the usual \$19.80, or a 50% discount on a pair of bowls.

The Midday Buddy Combo is available from 20 April (Monday) to 24 April (Friday) 2026, every day between 1pm and 5pm. The four-hour window is the tightest of the three, so set a reminder if you are thinking of swinging by after lunch for an afternoon snack to share with a colleague.

What is the Hainanese Fragrant Rice Kick Bowl?

The Hainanese Fragrant Rice Kick Bowl is Popeyes Singapore's localised rice-bowl riff on the Hainanese chicken rice flavour profile — aromatic pandan-scented rice topped with the chain's Signature Chicken or tenders and finished with sauces that nod to the chicken-rice genre without trying to imitate it exactly. It is a bowl format, so it travels well for takeaway.

At \$4.95 per bowl (effectively, when you split the \$9.90 two-bowl price), the Midday Buddy Combo is priced below a typical hawker chicken-rice set in 2026 — which is part of why Popeyes has placed it in the off-peak afternoon window to catch students and shift workers between meals.

The fine print

As with the other two promotions, the Midday Buddy Combo is valid for dine-in and takeaway only, excludes Changi Airport T1, cannot be combined with other offers, and is — while stocks last —. Outlets may also cap the number of combos per transaction to keep the queue moving.

How the three Popeyes promotions compare

On a pure dollar-per-saving basis, the Chicken Week Full Bucket Set is the heaviest hitter — \$15.60 off the usual price, or a straight 50% discount, with the widest hours (12pm to 9pm) and the longest run (seven days). If you are feeding a group or stocking an office lunch, that is the deal to hit.

For a per-person steal, the Midnight Crunch 1-for-1 Midnight Buddy Combo at \$5.15 per head is the lowest effective cost, but it requires you to be out after 10pm and to live near one of the 12 participating late-night outlets. It is a lifestyle deal more than a family one.

The Midday Buddy Combo is the sleeper of the three: four hours a day, five days a week, and \$9.90 for two bowls and two drinks. It is the best deal if you are a duo looking for a late lunch or a between-classes snack during the week.

Which outlet should you go to?

If you want all three deals in one location during the 20 to 24 April overlap, Kinex Mall, Northpoint City, Jurong Point, AMK Hub and The Seletar Mall are your best bets — these five appear on the Midnight

Crunch list and are full-service Popeyes outlets that carry the Chicken Week bucket and the Midday Buddy Combo. For a visitor staying in the city, Pan Pacific Orchard is the most central late-night stop on the list.

Popeyes Singapore: quick facts you should know

Popeyes Louisiana Kitchen is the New Orleans-style fried chicken chain that arrived in Singapore in 2001 and is now operated under the Restaurant Brands International family in the Singapore market. The local chain's chicken is halal-certified, which makes these promotions relevant across a wide range of diner demographics in Singapore family gatherings, mixed-religion office lunches and late-night workplace supper runs all sit within the halal bounds.

For the 20 April 2026 round of promotions, Popeyes is clearly targeting three different day-parts rather than running one blanket offer, and that is a shift from the single-promo months of earlier in the year. The trade-off: each deal has tighter rules, so you will need to read the fine print more carefully than usual.

Other food deals to check this week

If you are building a week of meals around promotions, Popeyes is not the only chain running deep discounts through the week of 20 April 2026. When do the Popeyes promotions end?

The two shorter promotions Midnight Crunch (10pm to 2am, Monday to Friday) and Midday Buddy Combo (1pm to 5pm daily) both end on Friday, 24 April 2026. The Chicken Week Full Bucket Set runs a bit longer and finishes on Sunday, 26 April 2026 at 9pm.

After 26 April 2026, Popeyes typically rolls over into its monthly Popeyes Week cadence the Full Bucket Set deal is reported to recur on the 20th to 26th of each month so if you miss this round, mark your calendar for May. The Midnight Crunch and Midday Buddy Combo formats, however, are offer-by-offer and may not repeat in the same structure.

The bottom line

Popeyes Singapore has given its customers a neat three-window playbook from 20 April 2026. For families and groups, the \$15 Full Bucket Set is a no-brainer in the 12pm to 9pm window all week. For couples on a lunch break, the \$9.90 Midday Buddy Combo is a sharp 50%-off pair-up. And for the after-hours crowd, the 1-for-1 Midnight Buddy Combo at \$10.30 available at 12 outlets is a late-night

bargain you will not see on the menu again in a hurry.

Whichever deal you are eyeing, read the fine print, skip the Changi Airport T1 outlet, and remember you cannot stack these offers with delivery promos or app vouchers. Get in early in each window especially after 10pm and you will walk away with one of the best chicken-to-dollar ratios in Singapore this week.
