



Post Malone Brings The BIG ASS Stadium World Tour To Singapore

Description

[Post Malone Presents The BIG ASS Stadium World Tour](#) has been added to Singapore's Kallang calendar, giving fans a clear date, venue and ticketing route to work with.

The key local detail is the venue scale. National Stadium is built for big concert and sports crowds, so tickets, transport and arrival timing matter as much as the headline name.

Date, Venue And Sale Details

Post Malone Presents The BIG ASS Stadium World Tour is listed for 25 September 2026 at National Stadium. Doors are listed for 6pm and the show for 8pm.

General sale started on 10 April 2026 at 12pm through Ticketmaster after artist, Mastercard, Trip.com and Live Nation presale windows. Live Nation is listed as promoter, with VIP packages available through the ticketing route.

- Date: 25 September 2026.
- Venue: National Stadium.
- General sale started on 10 April 2026 at 12pm through Ticketmaster after artist, Mastercard, Trip.com and Live Nation presale windows.

What Fans Should Know

This is a stadium-scale booking rather than an arena show, so the practical choice is between view, sound position and budget, not only whether a ticket is available.

The National Stadium timing also means the post-show train and taxi crowd will be substantial, especially if another Sports Hub venue has activity on the same night.

- Best for fans who want the full stadium production scale.
- Useful to plan dinner outside the immediate stadium rush if you want to avoid queues.

Planning Notes

If you are buying seated tickets, compare the section map before choosing by price alone. For stadium concerts, sight lines and distance from the stage can vary more than they do inside the Indoor Stadium.
