



Premier League Matchweek 37: Arsenal And Man City Final-Week Guide

Description

The Premier League title race rolls into the final week with Arsenal still in front and Manchester City still close enough to make every fixture feel heavy. After the weekend schedule was reshaped by the FA Cup final, the important context for Singapore viewers is that the run-in now stretches into Monday and Tuesday night football.

Arsenal entered the final stretch on 79 points from 36 matches, with City on 77 from 36. That keeps the race simple: Arsenal control the top spot, but City's rescheduled Bournemouth match means the pressure does not end with one weekend.

The Key Rescheduling

The Premier League confirmed Bournemouth v Manchester City and Chelsea v Spurs were moved from Sunday, 17 May to Tuesday, 19 May because of City and Chelsea's FA Cup final involvement. That turns Matchweek 37 into a staggered title and relegation watch rather than a clean Sunday finish.

For Singapore fans, the timing matters because the most important fixtures fall into late-night weekday windows. Check kick-off times before assuming the usual weekend rhythm.

Table Stakes

The title race remains Arsenal versus City, while the relegation story has narrowed to Tottenham Hotspur and West Ham United. That combination gives the final week two clear jobs: decide whether Arsenal can close out the league and determine who survives at the bottom.

Arsenal's margin means every dropped point changes the emotional temperature. City's recent wins over Brentford and Crystal Palace kept them alive, but the champions still need help from the fixture list and opponents.
