



PSG's Summer Revolution: Barcola Heads to Liverpool as Paris Reshape Their Squad

Paris Saint-Germain are reshaping their squad this summer in one of the most significant overhauls at the Parc des Princes in years. With Bradley Barcola's blockbuster move to Liverpool all but confirmed and fresh talent arriving at the French capital, **PSG summer transfers 2026** mark the beginning of a bold new chapter for the Ligue 1 giants.

Barcola's Blockbuster Exit â?? PSG Lose Their Star Winger

The biggest story of PSG's summer is undoubtedly the imminent departure of Bradley Barcola. The 23-year-old French winger is one of the most electric players in Ligue 1 over the past two seasons and has informed the club of his desire to move to the Premier League, with Liverpool emerging as his destination of choice. Reports from GiveMeSport and multiple outlets suggest the two clubs have agreed a deal worth in the region of €170 million, which would make Barcola one of the most expensive players in football history.

It is a significant blow for PSG supporters who have watched Barcola flourish since his arrival from Lyon. The winger finished the 2025/26 season as one of the most productive attackers in Ligue 1, contributing heavily in goal and assist tally. His direct running, explosive pace, and ability to cut inside on his right foot made him the focal point of PSG's attack. Losing him creates a major void on the left flank but the fee, if confirmed, will provide the club with extraordinary resources to reinvest wisely.

For fans of [Liverpool's new era under Andoni Iraola](#), Barcola represents the marquee arrival that signals serious intent at Anfield. For PSG, it marks the end of a chapter and the beginning of another.

New Arrivals: PSG Summer Transfers 2026 Shore Up the Squad

PSG have been active in replacing their departures while simultaneously improving the squad's structure. Marco Asensio arrives from Real Madrid on a free transfer, bringing World Cup winner's medals and elite European experience to the Parc des Princes. The Spanish international, who was part of the Spain squad that claimed glory at the 2026 World Cup in the United States, adds versatility and technical quality across the attacking line, capable of operating as a wide attacker or a number 10.

New goalkeeper Alessandro Longoni also completed his move to PSG in July, as the club addressed every area of the pitch in what has been a purposeful and strategically coherent window. Outgoing, PSG also parted with Gonalo Ramos, whose sale to AC Milan in a club-record deal generated

additional funds that feed directly into the rebuild. The net result is a leaner, more balanced squad that retains its Ligue 1 dominance while attempting to close the gap on Europe's elite.

Pre-Season Preview: Mallorca, Manchester United and the Road to Ligue 1

The pre-season schedule offers a tantalising glimpse of what PSG 2026/27 might look like. The Parisians face Mallorca on 6 August before a mouth-watering friendly against Manchester United on 8 August – a match that will attract significant attention from Singapore football fans given the global following both clubs command. Aston Villa follow on 13 August before the Ligue 1 campaign opens away to Lens on 17 August.

Whether this summer's rebuild can finally close the gap on Europe's elite – rather than merely maintaining domestic dominance – will define PSG's 2026/27 campaign. The combination of Asensio's proven quality, youth-oriented recruitment, and a war chest bolstered by Barcola's sale suggests Paris Saint-Germain are thinking bigger than ever.
