There are drop-in art experiences for all ages, many inspired by the museum's exhibitions. You can create tactile colour cards in *Feeling Colours*, try watercolour spray painting, experiment with cyanotype printing, make beaded charms, or have a go at punch needle. Face painting will also be on hand for the little ones.

## Carnival Vibes and Live Performances

It wouldn't be a carnival without games, treats and giveaways and SAM has those sorted too. Highlight performances include young Singaporean busker **Shayne Ko** and a spectacular smoke, magic and bubbles show.
