



Samsung 2026 TVs And Soundbars: What Homeowners Should Compare

What To Compare

Start with viewing distance and room brightness. A large TV can feel immersive in a wide living room, but overpower a compact BTO or condo layout if the sofa is too close.

Soundbars also matter more than many buyers expect. If you watch films, sport or concerts, a good soundbar can make a bigger difference than moving up one screen size. Samsung's launch offer ties selected free soundbars and e-vouchers to specific models, so compare the bundle as a whole rather than just the sticker price.

Before Buying

Measure the wall, console and lift access before ordering. Check whether wall mounting, delivery, old-device disposal and warranty registration are included or charged separately. For The Frame-style lifestyle TVs, also plan cable routing and where the screen sits when it is used as room decor.
